REASON FOR REQUEST:

The claimant, Daniel Jacobson, was a medical passenger in the back seat of a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling westbound on West North Avenue. The uninsured motorist was traveling westbound on West North Avenue in the front of the City vehicle when he unexpectedly made an illegal u-turn at the intersection of West North Avenue and North 57<sup>th</sup> Street, failing to yield the right away and striking the City vehicle on the front passenger side, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

The claimant, Mr. Jacobson, filed a lawsuit against the City of Milwaukee alleging that his injuries were caused by the negligence of both the uninsured motorist and the operator of the police vehicle. This proposed settlement would resolve all of the claims against the City of Milwaukee.

Mr. Jacobson sustained injuries to his head, neck, right elbow/leg and low back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$9,075.40.
