File # 070517 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a 2007 COPS Secure Our Schools Grant, and authorizing a subgrant to Milwaukee Public Schools for security measures in public schools.

Background

1. The U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), offers the Secure Our Schools Grant to fund security improvements in and around schools.
2. This is a pass-through grant. The Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) applies for the grant on behalf of Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) and sub-grants the funds to MPS.
3. This is a continuing grant. On December 12, 2006 the Common Council adopted CCFN 060978 in which COPS funded \$344,861 for security cameras in MPS schools and the school district matched the 2006 COPS grant for a total security camera budget of \$689,722. The 2006 grant extends from September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2008.

Discussion

1. COPS Secure Our Schools Grants have been subgranted to MPS since 2003.
2. Since 2003, 72 MPS buildings have received security cameras. A list of those buildings is attached to this analysis.
3. The MPS buildings to receive security cameras in 2007 have not been determined according to Peter Pochowski, Director of Safety and Security for MPS.
4. MPS and the City of Milwaukee will execute a memorandum of understanding (MOU) governing the sub-granting of these grant funds to MPS. The MOU will specify which buildings will receive security cameras.
5. COPS Secure Our Schools grant funding is expected to lessen in the future, and MPS's ability to match funds is also expected to lessen according to Mr. Pochowski.

Fiscal Impact

1. The total cost of this grant-funded project is \$652,600 of which \$326,300 (50%) will be provided by the grantor and subgranted by the City to MPS. MPS will provide the remaining \$326,300 (50%) of project costs. The City share is \$0.
2. The grant period is from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2009.
