
RE: Resolution relating to the Temporary Historic Designation of the former Forest Home Library at 1432 W. Forest Home Avenue in the 12th Ald. District.

Dear Ms. Kuehn and Mr. Vogel:

This letter is to inform you that the above matter was approved at the Historic Preservation Commission meeting of March 4, 2019 as the building meets the criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-1, e-5, e-6, and e-7, Milw. Code of Ordinances. Section e-1 relates to its exemplification and development of the cultural, economic, social or historic heritage of the city, state of Wisconsin or the United States. Section e-5 relates to a building's embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or specimen. Section e-6 relates to the building's identification as the work of an artistic, architect, craftsman or master builder whose individuals works have influenced the development of the city and section e-7 relates to its embodiment of innovation in architectural design or engineering, pre- or post-World War II, expressed in design, details, materials, craftsmanship, construction techniques or function of one or more buildings or structures.

The hearing for the permanent designation is scheduled for November 30th at 3:00 in City Hall, Room 301-A. A copy of the study report done by Historic Preservation Commission staff has been e-mailed to all parties.
