File #050234 is a communication transmitting a report entitled, Annual Acturial Statement of the Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Milwaukee for years ended December 31, 2004.

Background and Discussion

- The Policemen's Annuity & Benefit Fund (PA&BF) provides retirement benefits to police officers who were first employed prior to July 30, 1947.
- 2. As December 31, 2004, the fund had 70 annuitants and 125 widow annuitants.
- 3. The report projects the fund's estimated assets and liabilities for the years 2005 to 2014. The report assumes an annuity purchase for remaining annuitants on January 1, 2014.
- 4. The report shows that as of December 31, 2004 the PA&BF had total assets of approximately \$5.5 million and an unfunded liability of \$1.9 million.

Additional Information

To address the issue of the Fund's unfunded liability, on May 20, 2005 the Common Council adopted File#050067 a substitute ordinance relating to amortization of any unfunded, liability for the Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund. The ordinance changed the liability's amortization period from 5 to 10 years.

The PA&BF Board has also approved benefits improvements for all members increasing the minimum monthly payment from \$427 to \$500 per month and increasing payments for annuitants above the minimum by \$60.
