

Upon receiving this package last week, I contacted the GUEHLSTORF residence by telephone and spoke with the member's wife, Melanie. I did that on Friday, 04/30/99. She informed me that her husband was not home but that he would be. I informed her that he needed to come to the District and complete some paperwork and I told her what the paperwork was. She told me that she would relay the message and that he could take care of the matter on Monday. She said he was too busy to do it any sooner and that they were in the process of moving to a different home in the Milwaukee area.

On Monday the member failed to appear to sign these forms. I instructed the Early Shift Acting Lieutenant, Sgt. Mark JOHNSON to call the residence and inquire if the member would show up. Sgt. JOHNSON did call and found the member's telephone number to be disconnected. On Tuesday, I sent Sergeant John PEDERSEN of the 2nd District to the member's listed address and the GUEHLSTORF family no longer lives there.

I am unable to serve this on the officer.
