Dear Mr. Gatzow:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$2,415.69, relating to damages sustained to your 2021 Chevrolet Suburban, on March 16, 2022, when it was parked at 4150 S. Herman Street.

Our investigation reveals that, on March 17, 2022, the City garbage truck and recycling vehicles were in the area to complete services on S. Herman Street between 10:10am - 10:50am. The Sanitation Department reported that garbage trucks and recycling vehicles drive down the middle of the roadway to collect garbage on both sides of S. Herman Street. The garbage truck did not hit any vehicles during the collection of these services.

According to the witness Dorothy Booker, said she saw a garbage truck worker get out of the garbage truck to look at the vehicle and shook his head, then drove away after striking her son's parked vehicle.

There is no evidence that the City is negligent. As such, the City is not liable for your damages and we are denying your claim.
