Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

This claim is being submitted under §895.35(2), STATS., which provides that:

Notwithstanding sub (1), the City . . . shall reimburse a protective services officer for reasonable attorney fees incurred by the officer in connection with a criminal proceeding arising from the officer's conduct in the performance of official duties, unless, in relation to that conduct, any of the following applies:

- a. The officer is convicted of a crime;
- b. The officer's employment is terminated for cause;
- c. The officer resigned for reasons other than retirement before the attorneys fees are incurred;
- d. The officer is demoted or reduced in rank
- e. The officer is suspended without pay for 10 of more working days. §895.35(2), STATS.

Officers Knight and Boyack are both considered a "protective services officer" under the statute. They have incurred the fees compiled in this claim as a direct result of their being investigated for actions taken within their official capacity, and in the performance of their duties, in

connection with the use of deadly force. None of the "exceptions" apply¹.

The incident resulted in the District Attorney's Office conducting a criminal investigation into the shooting of Mr. Robert Agnew including an inquest, under Chapter 979, STATS. That investigation qualifies as a "proceeding" which mandates payment under 895.35(2), STATS.

Attached is the letter from DDA Reddin confirming that the use of deadly force was justified, privileged and in self-defense.

Dear Chief Hegerty:

As you are aware, Robert Agnew died of gunshot wounds after being shot by officer Jacob Knight on November 13, 2005. This afternoon, a Circuit Court inquest jury found that officer Knight's actions were privileged as an act of self-defense under Wisconsin Statutes section 939.48.

We agree wholeheartedly with this verdict. Officer Knight fired after Mr. Agnew pointed a handgun at him from a distance of about 10 feet. He is fortunate to have been able to fire first, and had no choice but to use deadly force.

As far as this office is concerned, this matter is closed.
