Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 111500

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 111500, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Cornerstone East LLC to construct and maintain a lannon stone retaining wall in the public right-of-way for the premises at 4080 North Port Washington Avenue.

The applicant is requesting permission to construct and maintain a 38-foot 7-inch long lannon stone retaining wall projecting an average of 4 inches into the east, 10-foot wide sidewalk area of North Port Washington Avenue. Said retaining wall has an average height of 2 feet 2 inches and total thickness of 1 foot.

We are not aware that the presence of said retaining wall will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, allow said retaining wall to occupy the public right-of-way.
