



## Equity Impact Statement

1. Describe the proposed ordinance or resolution.

The 2021 Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Grant (MMDEG) is an ongoing grant that will provide funding for the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to reduce crime and enhance the quality of life in the city of Milwaukee by reducing the volume of controlled substances in the area. The grant will partially fund the salaries of one Sergeant and two Police Officers to continue their collaboration with state and federal partners to combat drug trafficking. Multi-jurisdictional drug task forces enhance inter-agency cooperation, intelligence sharing, and lead to successful prosecutions for drug crimes.

No equity impacts are anticipated.
