Pursuant to law, the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee will hold a meeting on Tuesday, December 13, 2016, in the Common Council Chambers, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time the following legislation will be considered.  
Legislation will be considered relating to establishing the boundary of Neighborhood Improvement District No. 6 (Historic Garden Homes) and approving its Initial Operating Plan for the area generally bounded by West Hampton Avenue at North 27th Street proceeding east on the south side of West Hampton Avenue to North Teutonia Avenue; proceeding south on the west side of North Teutonia Avenue to West Roosevelt Drive; proceeding east on the north side of West Roosevelt Drive to North 27th Street; and proceeding north on the east side of North 27th Street to end at West Hampton Avenue, in the 1st Aldermanic District.
