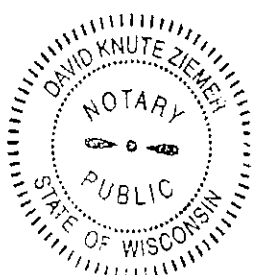

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the November 3, 2009 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance relating to a change in zoning from Two-Family Residential to Local Business on land located North of West Fond du Lac Avenue and West of North 37th Street, the former Robinson Middle School, in the 7th Aldermanic District.

Resolved: That the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:

Part I. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

Section 295.6012.0036. The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the property located at 3245 North 37th Street bounded and described as follows: That part of lands and Block 3 of Richard Brews' Subdivision and vacated North 38th Street lying between West Concordia Avenue, West Fond du Lac Avenue and North 37th Street in the Southwest 1/4 Section of Township 7N, North Range, E21, East, from Two-Family Residential (RT2) to Local Business (LB2).

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, December 15, 2009 at 9:00 A.M. pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee may attend this meeting to participate or to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.
