My name is _____ and I just recently purchased a home located at _____ I truly believe they are using this as a way to keep people from parking in front of their home or for personal reasons. We have six home that are all duplex's or multifamily homes which means we have 12 homes one the block. On our cul da sac it is limited parking due to such a small circle. From the time I purchased the home _____ I have not seen a reason for a loading zone to be 14 hours out of the day when NO ONE at all is being helped to and from the door to the vehicle. I also noticed that my neighbors don't use the front door because they park their vehicles in the garage and use the side door to enter. I have never seen a vehicle pull up and a person exist a vehicle that needs assistance to and from the door. I contacted my alderwoman Nakiya Dodds and was told by her assistant I would be contacted regarding my concerns about the loading zone. I took it upon myself to call the hotline and ask questions due to no response. I was then told that the loading zone is up for a renewal and which Traffic Code the physician used 101-23-7-1B. I looked online at the Traffic Codes for the loading zone and the code listed and not to say no one has a disability but no one in the house is being helped to and from the door with assistance due to not walking. I strongly disagree with the renewal and with the hours permitted which is 14 hours that's from 6 am until 8 pm 14 hours of the day and no one is utilizing the loading zone as permitted. If possible can someone just go out and verify and you will see that what I have stated is accurate.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
