

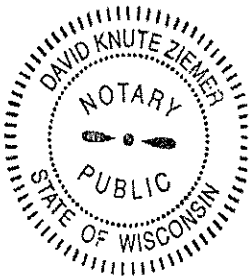

Leonhardt, City Clerk of the City of Milwaukee, certify that pursuant to Section 4-06-3 of the Milwaukee City Charter, notice is given of the passage of the following ordinances by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee on 03/25/2009, with the approval of Mayor Tom Barrett. The full text of each of the ordinances listed below can be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, Room 205, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 53202.

**080218...** A substitute ordinance relating to participation of city residents in public works contracts, requirements for developers receiving direct financial assistance from the city, and local business enterprise contracting standards.

**080685...** A charter ordinance relating to award of contracts to lowest bidders in conjunction with standards for preference for local business enterprises.

**081310...** Substitute ordinance relating to a change in zoning from General Planned Development to Detailed Planned Development, on land located on the East Side of South Howell Avenue and North of East College Avenue, for hotel development, in the 13th Aldermanic District.

**081312...** Substitute ordinance relating to the Third Amendment to a Detailed Planned Development, known as Pick 'n Save, formerly known as Home Depot, on land located on the South Side of West Good Hope Road and East of North 76th Street, for a full-service grocery store, in the 9th Aldermanic District.

**081383...** An ordinance relating to the use and operation of parking meters.

**081404...** A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2009 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

**081405...** A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2009 offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

**081408...** A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

**081409...** A substitute ordinance relating to traffic controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

**081476...** An ordinance relating to charges for patient services delivered by the fire department.

**081522...** An ordinance amending the elevator landing inspection fee.

**081553...** An ordinance amending the license period for publicly accessible collection bin provider and bin permits.
