The Menomonee Valley is the ancestral home of the Potawatomi Tribe, and through their sustainable building designs and community investments, they have provided Milwaukee with fine examples of stewardship. MVP looks forward to working with the City of Milwaukee and Potawatomi Bingo Casino to integrate the Menomonee Valley Sustainable Design Guidelines into this project. MVP is grateful to have in Potawatomi a partner dedicated to the future of the Menomonee Valley and the Milwaukee community as a whole.
