REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM

The City of Milwaukee's Community Block Grant Administration (CBGA), through the Community and Economic Development Committee, has available funding for agencies in the City of Milwaukee to organize and implement Summer Youth Programs for youth from low and moderate income families residing in the CDBG target area and for the express purpose of providing positive activities in and outside of the school environment.

Eligible activities include: recreational, educational and employment activities or any combination thereof and eligible administrative costs associated with these activities.

The timeline for these projects to start is June 1, 2005 with a completion date of August 31, 2005.

Maximum grants cannot exceed \$5,000 per applicant and will be limited to one-time only funding and will be non-renewable. All grants are paid on a **reimbursable** basis. Applicants must meet certain eligibility criteria as to non-profit status **at the time of application** and project location among others, to be eligible for a grant. In addition, applicants must obtain necessary insurance coverage as a condition of funding. Funds will be awarded in the most effective and efficient manner so as to assist as many applicants as possible.

Funds cannot be utilized to expand or subsidize existing year-round programs currently funded by CBGA. Funds are for summer programs *only*.

Applications will be available Wednesday, June 15, 2005. The closing date for the receipt of applications is 4:00 P.M., Friday, June 24, 2005. Faxed applications will not be accepted and applications received after this date will not be accepted.
