This is in response to your request on behalf of a local resident to install the above-captioned parking restrictions. Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found east and west bound motorists on East Meredith Street have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling north and south bound on South Delaware Avenue when vehicles park close to the corners. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing these restrictions to increase visibility at the intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
