**Dear Council Members:** 

Claimant, Billy Siggers, 8551 West Grantosa Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53225, alleges that on June 18, 2014 he sustained damages when a City sewer backed up into the basement of his residence. He claims damages in the amount of \$53,200.00.

The Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) records indicate that on June 18, 2014 they responded to a call of a backwater at 8551 West Grantosa Drive. They found the City main sewer to be clogged with heavy grease. A Sewer Jet was used to open the sewer and restore it to proper working order. Subsequently, the ISD televised the sewer and found structural deficiencies in a section of the downstream sewer. They scheduled a replacement of this section. The ISD records also indicate that the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and was last cleaned, prior to this incident,

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on October 7, 2013. Because the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and the City did not have notice of problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Therefore, we recommend that this claim be denied.
