1. Describe the proposed ordinance or resolution.

The 2024 Wisconsin Department of Transportation Bureau of Transportation Safety Speed Enforcement grant will provide overtime funding for the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to conduct highly visible traffic enforcement to decrease fatal and serious injury traffic crashes. This grant aims to increase voluntary compliance with traffic regulations while decreasing fatalities and serious injury collisions by focusing on targeted driving violations including speed, aggressive driving, and operating while under the influence. The MPD will participate in a speed enforcement task force including the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Police Department.

Identify the anticipated equity impacts, if any, of this proposal.

No equity impacts are anticipated.

3. Identify which minority groups, if any, may be negatively or positively impacted by the proposal.

Speed and reckless driving enforcement funded in part through this grant is intended to improve the safety of Milwaukee streets and neighborhoods. The high visibility enforcement campaign will deploy enforcement action based on observed/detected violations for speed and reckless driving including excessive speeding, aggressive and hazardous driving, and operating while under the influence that is not expected to negatively impact any minority group.
