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

ber 12, 2010 meeting of the Milwaukee Comman Council, the essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relating to a change in zoning from Single-Family Residential to a General Planned Development known as Growing Power, for development of a vertical farm and accessory uses, on land located on the north side of West Silver Spring Drive and west of North 55th Street, in the 9th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Cammon Coun-cil"), do ordain as follows.

Part 1. There is added to the Milwau-kee Code of Ordinances ("Cade") a new section to read as follows: Section 295-907(2)(a).0059

(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907(2) of the Code relating to the procedures and establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the sub-ject General Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Com-mon Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

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(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the properties located at 5500 West Silver Spring Drive, Tax Key No. 173-0168-000, and part of 5532 West Silver Spring Drive, Tax Key No. 173-0312-000.

(3) The requirements set forth in said-general plan attached to this Comman Council file as Exhibit A, constitute the zaning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such general plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, lacation, use and operation of all land and structures included within the general plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such general plan. such general plan.

Part 2. Any persans, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling or managing any building or premises wherein or wherean there shall be placed at there exists anything in violation of the torselvent of the control of the contr tian of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to an approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Devaluations partment of City Development, or any persan, firm, company or corporation any act required in this ordinance shall

ony act required in this ordinance statistics be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.

Part 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provisian, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sen-

one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.
