The department has reviewed the protest petition relative to Ordinance File No. 080543 and the requirements of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Chp. 295-61 of the and Wis. Stat. Sec. 62.23(7)(d)2m.a.

The property denoted by the signatures represents more than 20% of the immediately adjacent property extending 100 feet from the property line. If the petition meets all other related filing requirements as determined by the City Attorney, it is valid and will require a ¼ vote of the Common Council to approve the ordinance.
