There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity, public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

At 11:15pm the officer returned and Lewis still could not produce her bartender's license. When the officer told Lewis he was going to close the business, Lewis called the applicant who came to the business and was told to remain until such time as a Lewis could produce her bartender's license. At 2:01am the officer returned to the business and Lewis produced her bartender's license.

6. On 01/21/2017 Milwaukee police responded to St. Joseph's Hospital for a Battery-Cutting. 8. On 12/05/2018 at 1:43am officers conducted a licensed premise check on Gold Diggers, 4750 N. Hopkins St. The officers spoke with the manager, Kevin CLAYTON, who stated they were closing for the night. The officers did not observe any violations.

- 9. On 12/29/2018 officers observed an auto blocking traffic in front of 4750 N. Hopkins St. They observed the driver exit the auto and walk toward the sidewalk. The officers stopped the subject and found he was an employed as a DJ by Gold Diggers but was not working that night. The subject was observed throwing down suspected marijuana and he stated he had a firearm in his waist band. The subject was arrested for Possession of Marijuana while Armed.
- 10. On 02/07/2019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at Gold Diggers, 4750 N. Hopkins St. The officers were at the location for follow up regarding an incident the happened at another location but the victim and suspect hat been at Gold Diggers prior to the incident. The bar was cooperative with the officer and provided the video. On 02/08/2019 the officer received a complaint from a neighbor that stated there was loud music coming from Gold Diggers on 02/07/2019. The time of the complaint was 1:58am but the officer was in the tavern at that time and stated the music was turned off at 1:45am and never turned back on. On Friday, August 10, 2018 at approximately 1:58 AM, Squad 7468 (P.O. Andrew WILKIEWICZ and I) was dispatched to 4731 N. Hopkins St. regarding a ShotSpotter call for service. While in the area conducting our investigation we observed an abundance of vehicles parked in the 4700 block of N. Hopkins St., in the vicinity of Gold Digger's Gentlemen's Club located at 4750 N. Hopkins St. We also observed patrons gathered outside of the main entrance to the establishment. Knowing the tavern is supposed to be closed at 2:00 AM, we suspected the establishment might be operating afterhours.

The approximate time was 2:10 AM. P.O. WILKIEWICZ, I and Squad 7330 (P.O. Max OURS and P.O. Daniel STURMA) conducted a tavern check regarding. (CAD #: 182220235)

While walking up to the front door of the tavern we observed a group of 7-10 subjects standing outside, we observed one subject turnaround, open the door and whistle into the tavern. As we approached the group they slowly dispersed, appearing to go to their vehicles. As we got to the door we observed 3-5 subjects exiting the tavern. Upon entering the tavern we observed multiple patrons still inside. One patron was wearing a white tank top and red shorts was observed seated at the bar drinking from a disposable plastic cup. The same patron was also observed holding a freshly opened bottle of liquor, and also drinking from a wine/champagne glass. Another patron was observed seated at the stage also with a cup of alcohol.

The working bartender was identified as Lakita D LEWIS (b/f, 10-17-74). When LEWIS was asked when the patrons inside of the bar were served their last drinks LEWIS stated at approximately 1:15 AM. However the bottle of liquor in front of the patron that was seated at the bar was still cold to the touch and had condensation on it, consistent with the bottle recently being open. Furthermore, when the patron was told to leave he attempted to leave the tavern with the open bottle of liquor. When asked why patrons were still inside of the bar LEWIS stated they don't listen to her when she tells them to leave, and security doesn't work Thursday nights so it is difficult for her to ensure everyone is out at bar close. When asked, LEWIS was able to provide a valid Wisconsin State issued Class D Bartenders License.

After all patrons were cleared we requested to speak to the manager. The manger was identified as Kevin M CLAYTON (b/m, 11-22-74). CLAYTON appeared from the basement door. When speaking with CLAYTON, CLAYTON appeared to possibly be under the influence, based on his bloodshot eyes. CLAYTON stated he was unaware that there were still patrons inside of the bar since he was downstairs counting money. When asked, CLAYTON could not provide his Wisconsin State issued Class B Manager's License and stated he is not issued one.

CLAYTON was issued a citation for operating without a Class B Managers License (Citation #: 19817ZH5QT)

On Monday, February 11, 2019, Squad 7468 (P.O. Rebecca RODRIGUEZ and I) was dispatched to Gold Diggers (4750 N. Hopkins St.) regarding a noise nuisance complaint (CAD#:190422757) . The caller, whom

was identified as Roshounda CLEVELAND (b/f, 07-27-70) stated she could hear loud music coming from 2 -3 vehicle outside of the tavern. CLEVELAND was unable to provide a vehicle description.

Upon arriving on scene, we drove southbound on N. Hopkins St. past 4750 N. Hopkins St. Myself and P.O. RODRIGUEZ both rolled down our windows in an effort to see if could hear excessive noise coming from any vehicles parked in the 4700 block of N. Hopkins St. It should be noted I observed approximately 3-5 vehicle parked on the west side of N. Hopkins St. and approximately 3-5 parked on the east side of N. Hopkins St. Only one vehicle appeared to be occupied and it was determined no excessive noise was coming from inside of that vehicle.

We then turned eastbound onto W. Hampton Ave. and then southbound on N. 37th St. No vehicles were observed parked on N. 37th St. We then conducted another lap around the block, yet again passing the tavern, determining there was no excessive coming from the vicinity of the tavern.

We then changed locations to 4750 N. 37th St. to speak with CLEVELAND. While speaking with CLEVELAND she stated earlier in the evening she heard loud music coming from vehicles parked in front of Gold Diggers. CLEVELAND stated it has become a persistent issue and she is upset because the bar doesn't have "professional security" to deal with their clientele.

We then changed locations back to Gold Diggers and conducted a tavern check (CAD#: 190430011). While inside of Gold Diggers we observed approximately 6 staff members, and 3-5 customers. We advised security staff regarding CLEVELAND'S concerns. Security stated they will do their best to alleviate any excessive noise coming from vehicles that are parked outside of the tavern. They also stated it is difficult to do because in some cases, the vehicle parked on N. Hopkins St. are not associated to the tavern whatsoever.

It should be noted P.O. RODRIGUEZ, P.O. Andrew WILKIEWICZ and I, regular conduct patrols, investigations, and tavern checks based on CLEVELAND'S complaints, and on numerous occasions some of the complaints were found to be baseless.

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This report is written by Police Officer Andrew WILKIEWICZ, assigned to District 7, Late Power Shift.

On Friday, April 19, 2019, Squad 7468, Police Officer Marcel STOLZ and I, were dispatched to 4782 N Hopkins St. for a shotspotter complaint.

Upon arrival, I observed an employee of Gold Diggers Club (4750 N. Hopkins St.) sweeping up glass that was located in the street on the east side of W. Hopkins St. The employee stated that he was not sure what happened or how the glass got there. I spoke to another employee, Antonio M. JARVIS (B/M, 5/7/85), who stated that he believed that someone may have been shot because while inside the tavern, he heard shots fired and when the gunfire stopped and he believed it was safe to go outside he observed an unknown black male carrying another black male eastbound towards N. 37th St. where JARVIS stated that he believed the potential gunshot victim entered a waiting vehicle, which he did not observe, and flee. At the same time, P.O. STOLZ informed me that he had located some blood right where the broken glass was located. A short time later, it was relayed that a shooting victim arrived at St. Joseph's Hospital, which was related to our scene. JARVIS was cooperative with the investigation. All other employees of the tavern were also cooperative with the investigation.

I spoke to the manager at Gold Diggers, Kevin M CLAYTON (B/M, 11/22/74), who was cooperative and without hesitation allowed officers to review the taverns security footage and remained on scene, even after the tavern was closed, until the video was recovered. The video did have evidentiary value to the investigation.

It was learned during the investigation that the victim of the shooting intended to visit the tavern, however, never made entry into the tavern before he was shot and at this time, no other actors involved in this incident were inside the tavern at any point in the evening prior to the shooting.
