
Re: File No. 121255, Substitute resolution relating to the permanent historic designation of the George Knowles, Jr. House at 1879 N. Cambridge Avenue, in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

At a public hearing held on January 14, 2013, the Historic Preservation Commission, by a vote of five (5) ayes, zero (0) noes, and two (2) excused, recommended permanent designation of the George Knowles, Jr. House located at 1879 N. Cambridge Avenue as a historic site in accordance with provisions of Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, based upon criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-1, e-5, and e-9. Attached is the Historic Designation Study Report, which contains the preservation guidelines recommended by the Commission for the site.

Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances provides that the Common Council shall review the recommendation of the commission and take final action. You will be notified of the time and location of the Common Council Zoning, Neighborhoods & Development Committee hearing if you wish to speak further on the matter.
