File #010531 is a resolution authorizing settlement of the lawsuit entitled Dean Monfre v. City of Milwaukee, Case Number 01-CV-001701.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. In September 1999, Dean Monfre, a painter in the Facilities Management Section of DPW-Buildings and Fleet Division, filed a workers' compensation claim regarding an injury to his neck from lifting a ladder.
- 2. Mr. Monfre collected injury pay before the Workers' Compensation Section of the Department of Employee Relations obtained a second doctor's opinion.
- 3. Based on the second doctor's opinion, Worker's Compensation Section denied liability for Mr. Monfre's injury.
- 4. The City of Milwaukee withheld wages and other benefits because Mr. Monfre was overpaid injury pay benefits.
- 5. Attorney Lynne Zuehlsdorf-Mack represented Mr. Monfre in his lawsuit which claims that the City of Milwaukee illegally withheld his wages and benefits in violation of s.109.03(5) Wis. Stats.
- 6. Specifically, Mr. Monfre and his attorney maintained that deductions from his paycheck to reimburse the City of Milwaukee for the injury pay he received in error were illegal.
- 7. The City of Milwaukee and Mr. Monfre have agreed to settle this lawsuit.
- 8. In consideration of a mutual release, the City of Milwaukee has agreed to pay back pay to Mr. Monfre and to pay fees and costs to Mr. Monfre's attorney, Ms. Zuehlsdorf-Mack.

## Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the expenditure of \$4500 from Department Salary Account #0001 6001010-5455. \$4500 is the total of \$2,050 payable to Attorney Lynne Zuehlsdorf-Mack for attorney fees and costs and \$2,450 payable to Dean Monfre in full and final settlement of this lawsuit.
