

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Michael Dukat, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and on a bicycle patrol traveling westbound on Lincoln Avenue in a marked bicycle lane. After proceeding through the intersection of West Lincoln Avenue and South 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Officer Dukat was struck from behind by an intoxicated, uninsured motorist, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

As a result of the impact, Officer Dukat was thrown from his bicycle and sustained a closed head injury, a concussion, and injuries to his shoulders, right leg, right knee, right elbow, and right hand. The treating physicians have indicated that the right shoulder and right hand injuries are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$110,769.56.
