Customers continually would drive up to this damage pump as well as other pumps nearby as they tried to obtain gas. The manager, Emad Khan, arrived on scene at 8:00 am and began placing black plastic bags with yellow out of order bags on the nozzles of the broken pump. Khan was advised to notified the owner to which Khan stated that he was already in enroute to the station.

This Report is written by PO Russell MACRAE assigned to District 5 - LATE POWER.

On 07/23/2020 at 07:01pm, PO David LETTEER and I (SQ#5448) were dispatched to 232 W Locust Street (BP-GAS) for a property damage complaint. Per the caller later identified as SINGH, Gupreet (W/M 06/05/1996) an unknown panhandler threw a rock or hard-like items at his personal vehicle causing damage. Upon arrival we made contact with SINGH who stated that a B/M who panhandles in front of the store had thrown a rock or unknown object at SINGH's personal vehicle causing damage. We asked SINGH to see the security camera footage.

Upon watching the video the following is a brief synopsis and not a detail account:

The Unknown B/M arrives at the store at approximately 01:00pm. The B/M walks inside and purchases a lottery scratch-off ticket. Afterwards, he proceeds to stand outside and ask numerous people for money. Eventually the B/M walks inside of the store and stands next to a rear counter. After a short time, one of the clerks only identified at this time as "KHALID" exits the enclosed clerk area. KHALID is holding a golf club and begins exchanging words with the B/M. KHALID proceeds to strike/push the B/M in the chest with the club causing a backwards motion. The B/M then is visibly upset/angry and proceeds to walk outside. It is at that time, the B/M walks to a nearby grassy-knoll and finds some object to throw at SINGH's personal vehicle causing damage.

I asked SINGH why KHALID would have done what he did. SINGH did not know. SINGH called the "stores manager" verbally identified as GARWAR, Ghulam (W/M 08/01/69). I informed GARWAR of the incident and asked if this is usual practice for the business. GARWAR became defensive and stated that "so it's ok for him to ask for money and not listen?" I informed GARWAR that no...it is not okay for a business to strike/push a patron with a golf club. I informed GARWAR that I would be filing a License/Premise Report regarding the incident and making contact with the Licensee.

GARWAR stated that he planned to "contact his lawyer".

I later attempted to contact the Licensee identified as BEG, Kalim. The cell phone went to voicemail where I left a detail message and contact information.

At this time, 07/26/2020 we are unable to identify the identity of the B/M panhandler.


