Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, lilegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. #### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by PO Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Saturday, March 11, 2023, I was assigned to work for the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Prevention. Assisting in this assignment was Maurice L. NEWTON B/M 01/27/06 of 5102 S. Nicholson Ave., Cudahy, WI 53110 and Miliani J. DIAZ H/F 12/30/06 of 1729 S. 1st St. Milwaukee, WI 53204. Neither NEWTON is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 1:00P., NEWTON entered Goodspot Foods, located at 2201 W. National Av., and purchased a 2 pack of Honey flavored Dutch Cigars. NEWTON described the employee as a A/M in his 30's wearing a Navy-Blue Sweater. NEWTON stated the employee did not ask or check his identification.

I entered the store and identified the employee based on the description given. The employee was identified as: Ahmad ALABAD A/M 12/30/90 of 4849 S. 13th ST. ALABAD denied the sale and stated his boss was in the building as well and also had on a blue sweater. I requested ALABAD call his boss to the front of the store so I could interview him and ALABAD picked up the phone and started calling someone. I asked ALABAD why he would be calling him on the phone instead of just yelling out to him, to which ALABAD stated he had just left. I advised ALABAD I was just sitting out in front of the store and no one matching that description left the building. I advised ALABAD I did not believe his story that it was his boss that sold the tobacco as I entered the store within a minute of the youth leaving and it would have been almost impossible to take over that quickly and me not observe another employee. ALABAD was provided with educational materials regarding the violation as well as a digital calendar to assist in future age-related tobacco sales.

I made contact with the agent, Mazen T. MUSTAFA A/M 11/22/82 and advised him of the incident. MUSTAFA was very apologetic and stated he was in the process of selling the business. MUSTAFA stated the new owners began employment at the location pending the granting of their license. MUSTAFA stated he does understand he is still responsible for the Licensed Premise until the license is granted to the new owner.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 2/13/2024 at 9:35 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
