There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.



This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/26/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 5219 West Hampton Avenue (Comments Lounge). Investigation revealed that a bar patron was walking into the business when an unknown actor fired two shots from a vehicle in the parking lot. The victim was struck in the hand. Milwaukee police incident report #142380203 filed.

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2. On 04/05/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 5219 West Hampton Avenue (Comments Lounge). Officers discovered four shooting victims, two of whom expired on the sidewalk in front of the business. One of the victims was former security officer for the business. Milwaukee police incident report #150950026 filed.
3. On 09/27/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a loud music complaint at 5219 West Hampton Avenue (Comments Lounge). Officers discovered the front door of the business was locked and gained entry after knocking. Officers then warned the applicant regarding the loud music and also advised him that the front door needs to remain unlocked while the establishment is open.

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4. On 12/30/2015 Milwaukee police responded to 5219 West Hampton Avenue (Comments Lounge) for the establishment operating without a license. The officer discovered the front door to be locked and was told the business was hosting a private party. The applicant told the officer he did not pay a fine and the license was not renewed. A DJ told the officer it was karaoke night. The applicant was issued two citations.

5. On 10/09/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a subject with a gun at 5219 West Hampton Avenue (Comments Lounge Tavern). Upon arrival an officer located an individual suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. Investigation revealed there had been an altercation outside the business culminating in the victim being shot. The victim died from his wounds. Based on evidence the victim arrived on scene and two subjects began to shoot at him. The applicant did cooperate with police during this investigation. The applicant did not know the names of the security guard or bartender that was working at the time of the incident. Milwaukee police incident report # 162830028 filed.
6. On 11/04/16 a meeting was held at District Seven at the request of the Jon Ragland, the agent for Comments Lounge. Mr. Ragland requested the meeting to discuss the homicide and how he could safeguard his business from further problems. Some ideas discussed were purchasing a card reader, age restriction, and holding a meeting with the community and local alderman.

This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. On 10/9/2016 at 2:39am I responded to 5219 W Hampton Av (Comments Lounge Tavern) regarding a subject with a gun complaint. Upon my arrival on scene I located one individual that was suffering from a single gunshot wound to the head. The victim was later identified as Timothy L OLINGER JR (B/M, 10/27/83).

During the investigation the owner of the tavern was on scene and he cooperated with the investigation. The investigation revealed that there was an altercation outside of the tavern and that the altercation lasted for approximately 20 minutes. Based on the evidence observed the victim, OLINGER JR arrived on scene and two subjects began to shoot at him striking him once and the injuries resulted in OLINGER JR'S death.

I observed several individuals at the tavern at the time I arrived on scene standing outside. When I approached the scene most of the patrons left the scene on foot or in vehicles. I ordered several people to remain inside of the tavern until I was able to interview them regarding the incident. During this time two of the subject I ordered back into the tavern were not immediately located upon entering the tavern.

One of the subjects was found hiding in the basement of the tavern in a back closet and the other subject may have fled the scene by jumping over a large fence on the back patio of the tavern. The subject found hiding in the closet was taken into custody for obstruction. Please review IR 16-283-0033 for additional information regarding.

It should be noted that RAGLAND was on scene during the incident and that he did cooperate with the investigation and provided officers with a statement regarding. It should also be noted that RAGLAND did not know the names of the security guard working nor his bartender working the night of the incident and he stated that he pays them cash and did not know their real names.

It should also be noted that RAGLAND did not provide information to officers as to his knowledge of the two subjects that attempted to hide and flee the scene from officers after being ordered back inside of the tavern.

During the investigation camera footage was recovered from the tavern. It should be noted that the camera system currently installed is a four camera system. One of the cameras is located inside of the tavern and points towards the front entrance of the tavern. A second camera is located on the west side of the building pointing west into a parking lot of the business next door. A third camera is on the north side of the building pointing west down the sidewalk and W Hampton Av. The fourth camera is on the east side of the building pointing to the south. It should be noted that there is a large blind spot that does not cover the northeast corner of the business and it did not capture the shooting incident. The cameras did capture the shooters and their vehicle fleeing the scene.

On 12/31/2015 at approximately 12:29am, I responded to 5219 W Hampton Av (Comments Lounge) for the establishment operating without a license. Upon my arrival the front door was locked and it took someone two minutes to open the door. I observed patrons with mixed alcoholic beverages and open beers. The owner Ron RAGLAND was on scene and stated that he was hosting a private party. PO TERPSTRA talked to the DJ, who stated that it was karaoke night. RAGLAND stated that he did not pay a fine and the license was not renewed. He then informed me that he was going to pay the fine on 12/31/2015.

The bartender was Tiffany L. CAMPBELL was on scene bartending. When asked for her bartender license she had to exit the bar and get it out of her vehicle.

Mr. Ragland contacted our unit regarding and requested a meeting to discuss how he could further safeguard his business from further problems. Mr. Ragland was accompanied by his manager, identified as Nathan Fraction. This meeting was also attended by our Assistant District Attorney, Hanna Kolberg, as well as our Tavern Car, Officer Brian Laroque. After introductions, representatives of the bar, the ADA, and officers discussed available options and ideas on how to assist the business. Some of the ideas included getting a license reader, adding an age restriction to the license, reach out to Alderman Rainey, reach out to the community and request a meeting with them at the tavern. Mr. Ragland took the information along with our business cards and informed us that he would be in contact regarding inviting police to the community meeting he is going to have.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

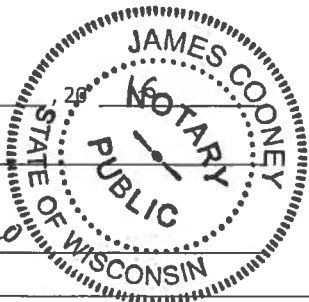
