File No. 011222 is a resolution authorizing the Fire Department to accept 2 grant allocations from the State of Wisconsin – Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management related to hazardous materials response services.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. The Milwaukee Fire Department provides emergency medical services (EMS) to the citizens and visitors of the City.
- 2. The State of Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management established a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services program to provide grant funds that subsidize municipalities' anti-terrorism emergency medical services efforts. The Milwaukee County Emergency Services is responsible for distributing grant funds to approved fire departments that can provide proof of purchasing qualified EMS equipment.
- 3. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Fire Department to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Program from the State of Wisconsin's Department of Health and Family Services.
- 4. These grant allocations are (1) a sum not to exceed \$4,000 for HAZ/MAT detection (gasmetering) equipment, and (2) a sum not to exceed \$1,000 for HAZ/MAT team computer equipment (laptop).
- 5. The grants will offset 2001 equipment costs.

## Fiscal Impact

1. The resolution authorizes the acceptance of a \$1,000 grant and a \$4,000 grant from State of Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs.
