There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/26/24 at 2:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6401 S. 13th street for a Theft. Investigation revealed this was an attempt stolen vehicle complaint and a report was taken. There were no video surveillance cameras that would have captured the incident. The hotel does have security, but were not present at the time of the incident. The employee was cooperative.
- 2. On 04/20/24 at 3:43am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6401 S. 13th Street for an Accident. Investigation revealed an employee observed a vehicle strike the building twice and park in the lot. Officers observed the damage on the vehicle but could not find the driver. A ticket was issued to the owner. The surveillance footage could not be retrieved and the employees were cooperative.
- 3. On 07/04/24 at 2:00am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6401 S. 13th Street for a Sexual Assault. Investigation revealed no sexual assault occurred, one subject was a missing, and another subject was conveyed to MEHC. The business was cooperative with the police.
- 4. On 10/02/24 at 8:15p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 6401 S. 13th St. On arrival officers located the victim with a gunshot wound to their arm, as well as blood in a stairwell and an elevator. The front desk clerk stated the victim appeared from around the corner and asked to use the phone as they had been shot. The front desk clerk moved the victim to a rear room and called police. They were cooperative and allowed officers to video

surveillance, however, it was of poor quality and did not cover areas which would have assisted in determining what occurred.

- 5. On 02/04/25 at 1246am., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 6401 S. 13th St. Investigation revealed the business called due to an intoxicated guest, causing a disturbance. The officer located the subject and escorted them back to their room.
- 6. On 04/05/25 at 1045pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6401 S. 13th St., for a Child Abuse complaint, which was deemed baseless. The business was cooperative.
- 7. On 04/18/25 at 756pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft at 6401 S. 13th St. Investigation revealed a guest room was ransacked and items were taken by a third-party contractor. The business was cooperative and they were working on identifying the subject.

This report was written by Police Officer Fabian Garcia assigned to District 6-Community Partnership Unit.

On Thursday, May 1st, 2025, at 2:00 pm, I met with the owner/licensee of the Crowne Plaza located at 6401 S. 13th Street, Mr. Rakesh Rehan.

The location is currently open. The location does have a sit down restaurant with bar and a snack arear near the front desk, where beer can be purchased long with various snacks and non-alcoholic drinks.

Mr. Rehan stated that the location currently has 66 surveillance cameras, which 12 are located in the exterior of the property and 54 interior cameras. Mr. Rehan stated that the current surveillance cameras have been updated and are of better quality. All interior cameras face the

entrances and exits and are located on every floor of the hotel. Mr. Rehan stated that the restaurant will be open from 6am-2am.

Mr. Rehan stated that they do have a contracted security company who are deployed every day from 9pm to 5am. States the duties of the security are to conduct roving patrols of their lots as well as walking patrols to the interior of their property.

A discussion of the standing complainant form was had and stated if they have issues with individuals loitering or trespassing they will be more than willing to be a complainant.




City Concentration Map for 6401 S 13th

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
