Your Food Dealer and Food Peddler Licenses Renewal Application as agent for "Street Munchies LLC" for "Street Munchies" at 3300 W Lincoln Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

and I own

I have been here for

more than 10 years. I am a proud citizen of Bay View and support all the dogs, festivals and events in Bay

I am writing this to address the food truck parking on the 2100 block of kk. Most days there are 2-4 food trucks parked on the east side of the street along Zillman Park taking up parking for the dozen plus small businesses on KK. On some days they are taking up as many as 6 parking spaces because in addition to the trucks Street Munchies has a truck attached to their kitchen and parks a van behind it. There is also a white van that parks closer to Paloma that saves a spot for another food truck to come later.

That side of the street is signed 2 hour parking.

This is my understanding of the ordinances for food truck parking:

Vehicles licensed for food peddling must obey all traffic laws and regulations. (MCO Ch. 101 Traffic Code)

You may not stop for more than two hours in any residential block and such stops must be separated by a six-hour period. You must be in compliance with all posted parking signs and limits. (MCO Section 115-45)

The food trucks in question, Taqueria Ayuujuk and Street Munchies on most days are there from 10:00 am or so until after we have closed, clearly violating the above ordinances.

I have attached pictures for evidence. The pictures are 4/29 3:15, 4/30 12:00, 5/1 11:52, 5/2 12:55, 5/5 2:15, 5/7 1:15, 5/9 10:37

Last November I brought this to the attention of my alderperson via email and received the response that DPW would do a study the week of Thanksgiving. I then received this response from Marina Dinitrijevic on December 16: "DPW Parking advised that they were unsuccessful in locating the food truck in violation. "Let me connect you with Eldricht directly here so that you can work together to resolve it. There must be some way to stop this. Thank you for reaching out"

I reached out via email to Eldricht Hill with no response.

I have since emailed licensing (they put a note in their file) and talked to the parking checker (he was lovely!) to no avail.


It is not an easy climate in which to run a small business and I do not understand why a business that can move anywhere is allowed to take away from businesses that can't. This affects every business within 2 blocks. When scouting locations, parking is a factor in where you put your business. I know in 10 years things change, but the 2 hour parking on this street has never changed, food trucks are just violating ordinances. Customers are not going to come to any of the stores or restaurants if they cannot find parking.


I would like recognition that this is a problem and would like a resolution. A couple resolutions could be to have designated food truck parking like other areas of Milwaukee; change the parking rules from 2 hour; set up food truck parking on Bay St. (1/2 block away but not taking parking from businesses).



To whom it may concern:

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/10/2025 at 10:45 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
