There is a possibility that your application may be denied  one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

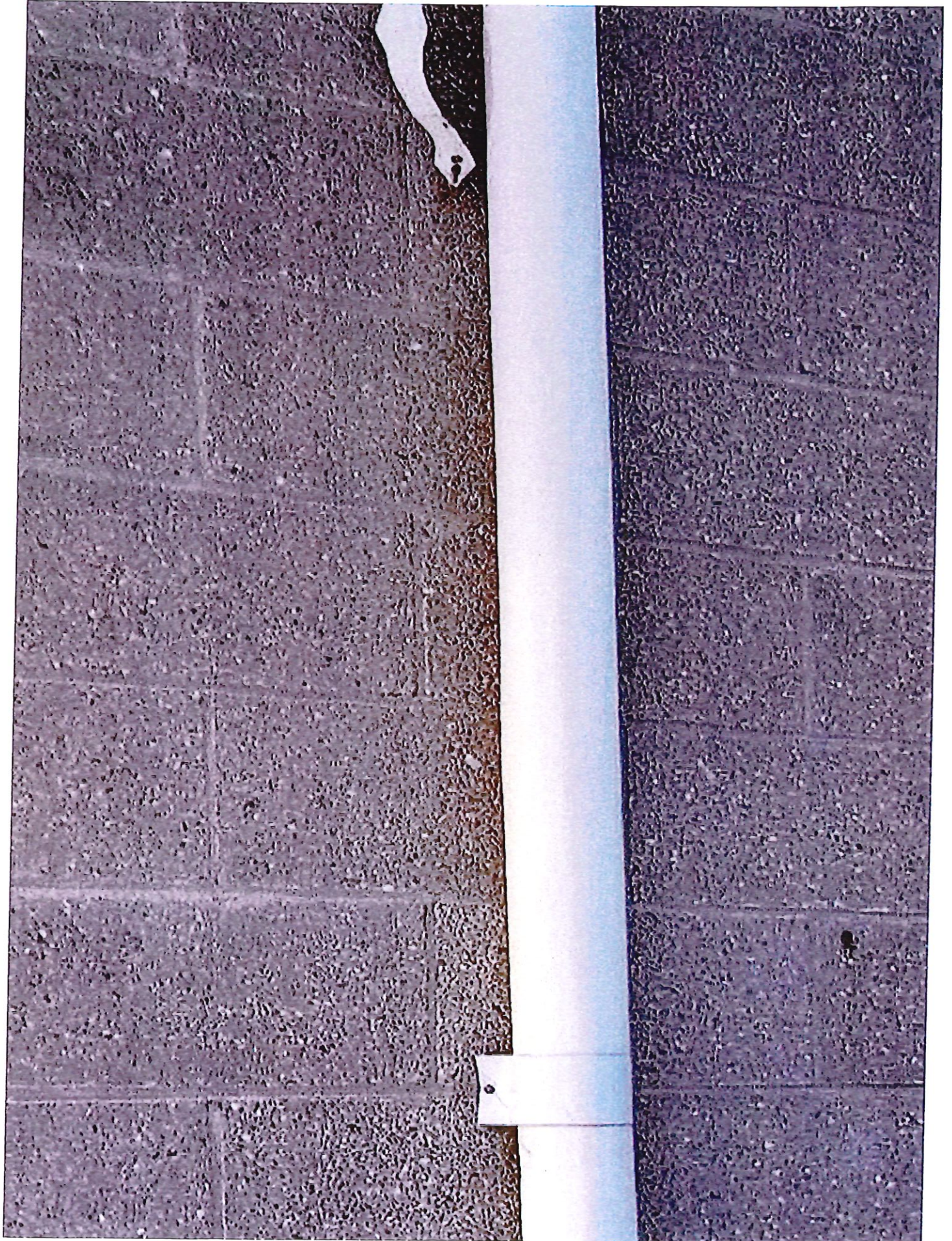
Good morning,

Faviola, Alderman Chambers is asking that we please make having a second dumpster to accommodate ongoing garbage overflow a condition of licensing for Lush Lounge.

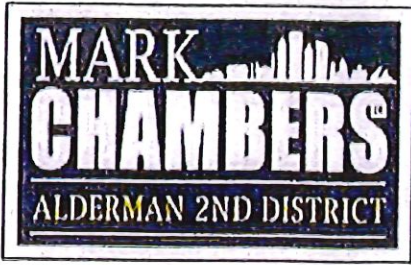
Ray, can you please have someone from Sanitation pick up the extra items and bags of garbage on the ground at Lush Lounge?

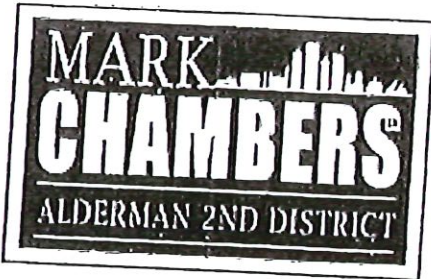

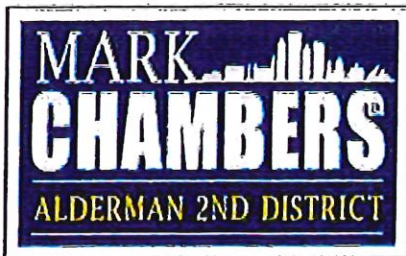

Again.. we never had this problem with Ald Davis and the previous owner of the strip mall.

We all worked together and had quarterly mtgs in the alley.

Mr Chambers please help the home owners out

Please do not blame the home owners for the rodent problem considering you see the pictures I send you.

Regarding the rodent issue, my office has sent inspectors out on every occasion that you requested, and we will continue to follow up with the appropriate departments to determine what additional measures can be taken. I also encourage the property owners to implement pest control measures to help mitigate the problem.

As for the ongoing dumping and cleanup concerns, we have consistently reached out to the responsible parties and will continue to push for action. To better address this issue, we have asked for security footage to help pinpoint those responsible for the dumping. If you or any nearby businesses have camera footage that could assist in identifying the culprits, please let us know.

I appreciate your patience, and I will keep you updated on any developments. Please don't hesitate to reach out with any further concerns.

4. NATURE OF CALL/JUSTIFICATION

On this same day, the caller of this complaint stated that Lush Social Lounge closes at 10:00 pm but there were still people at the location. The caller of this complaint requested that officers be sent to the location to investigate.

INVESTIGATION

PO MAJEED and I arrived at the mentioned address and parked our fully marked MPD squad car on the southern end of the parking lot of the strip mall. PO MAJEED and I then approached the business on foot. I observed a few individuals in the parking lot near vehicles outside of the lounge, but no one was directly in front of the main entrance to the business. As I stood in front of the front window of the lounge, I could see inside of the building and observed that all of the neon lights inside the building we turned off. The main entrance door of the business was locked when PO MAJEED and I arrived, and a security guard was seated just inside of the entrance door. The security guard unlocked the door and granted us access inside of the business.

Once inside of the business, I observed the business owner Givionte L. MULL (B/M 01/14/1996), standing near the main bar area. I observed employees cleaning multiple areas of the lounge and the staff behind the bar area were cleaning out hookahs and also throwing out trash. I then spoke to MULL who stated that he closed his business at the listed closing hours and the individuals inside were employees and a few lingering patrons who received their food order and was leaving the premise. MULL stated that there were no sales after 10:00 pm and the business was closed for service.

I did not observe any sales being conducted when PO MAJEED and myself arrived on scene nor when we were granted access into the business.

While inside of Lush Social Lounge, I could see individuals park their vehicles in the strip mall parking lot and proceed to Kinky's Lounge which is located next to Lush Social Lounge. MULL stated that people often confuse Kinky's crowd with being associated with his business due to the two buildings being side by side.

LICENSES

I then asked MULL for the business occupancy and operating licenses. MULL stated that he has the required documents, but the paperwork was at home in his

On 8/24/24 at approximately 11:00 pm, Alderman Mark Chambers called in reporting that he wanted a tavern shut down as they are operating outside of their permitted hours. Alderman Chambers stated there was a large disorderly crowd in the tavern parking lot, and stated he would wait for officers on scene. The address provided was "Lush" by Alderman Chambers was 5938 N 76th St. I contacted Alderman Chambers via phone, and he stated he was not on scene, and again advised they were outside of the hours.

I arrived at approximately 11:15 PM. Upon arrival, I observed the strip mall parking lot to be full to nearly capacity. I observed 50-75 people standing outside of cars and observed what appeared to be subjects engaging in gambling. These subjects gambling immediately scattered upon observing my marked squad vehicle.

I made my way to the Lush Door and observed approximately 8 subjects gathered around the bar sitting on bar stools. I observed multiple liquor bottles to be seated on the bar top. I knocked multiple times, flashed my flashlight inside, and announced police. It took approximately 5 minutes for anyone from Lush to answer the door.

I was eventually able to make contact with a subject who identified himself as the manager. This subject identified himself as Giovanni L Mull (b/m, 11/28/91)

I advised Mull that I was made aware that per his licensing agreement, his establishment was to close at 10:00 PM. I advised Mull that it was reported that his establishment was open well past the 10:00pm threshold.

Mull vehemently denied being open past 10:00pm. Mull stated that they began to advise the patrons to leave at approximately 9:30 pm, and by 10:00 pm, the only subjects left inside were staff members who were cleaning up. Mull stated regarding the parking lot being full, that those are not his patrons, but they are Kinky's lounge, which is located just north of Lush.

I asked Mull to view the licenses for his establishment, and he advised me that he would go get the business licenses. Approximately 10 minutes later, Mull came back and advised me that he did not have his licenses readily available to view, and he was unsure where they were. Mull admitted the licenses

Officers observed two cash registers located behind the bar area which were fully operational. MULL could not provide any licenses approved to sell alcohol, tobacco, nor does he have a entertainment license. Officers observed a full DJ on the premises playing music. DOR agents informed MPD officers that due to no license permits being issued for MULL to sell or distribute alcohol, the alcohol on the premise would be confiscated along with tobacco (hookah products). MULL was fully cooperative during this investigation and stated that he was under the impression that he had his licenses. It was explained to MULL that his licenses have holds on them so he does not have licenses at this time to operate. It also was explained to him that information regarding had been mailed and emailed to him two times in the past two months that he was not to be open for business. VLOSICH explained to MULL that his food license also has a hold due to his non compliance to submit information back to the City of Milwaukee Health Department and issued him a citation on scene. Officers observed food being cooked inside of the kitchen and patrons awaiting their food orders. Officers observed food being prepared, hookahs being smoked, alcohol being served and a DJ playing music on scene. All are infractions due to no licenses being held at this time.

I took overalls, mid range, and close up photographs of the entire establishment along with the alcohol, tobacco and food. I also photographed the confiscated


