**Emergency Medical Services Agreement
For Paramedic Services Between
Milwaukee County Department of Health and Human Services
And the City of Milwaukee**

Addendum

Effective January 1, 2004 the City of Milwaukee entered into an agreement with the County of Milwaukee for the provision of Paramedic Services. This agreement allowed for a one-year extension in the absence of a renegotiated agreement by December 1, 2005. It was agreed that the reimbursement structure for these services would be a combination of system revenue and County property tax levy. The distribution of funds was to be determined by the Intergovernmental Coordinating Council (ICC).

It is understood by both parties to the Agreement that effective January 1, 2006 in accordance with an ICC directive regarding the distribution of Paramedic System revenue and County property tax levy:

- The Emergency Medical Services Agreement for Paramedic Services Between Milwaukee County Department of Health and Human Services and the City of Milwaukee is extended through December 31, 2006.
- The distribution of tax levy at one seventeenth of three million dollars remains the same.
- For 2006 dates of service, the share of revenue percentage changes to fifty-two and nine tenths percent (52.9412%) of net collections minus any expenses as identified in 4.1.11 and subsequent subparagraphs of the 2004 – 2005 agreement.
- In light of the County's agreement to return all system revenue to host municipalities effective with January 1, 2004 dates of service, all net collections from 2004 dates of service and beyond generated by the Milwaukee County Tax Refund Intercept Program (TRIP) on behalf of the Emergency Medical Service program will be added to 2006 revenue. Net collections will consist of gross TRIP revenue minus all collection expenses.
- All other provisions of the agreement remain unchanged.

In witness whereof, the parties hereto, represented by officials authorized to bind them, have caused this addendum to the Agreement to be executed as of January 1, 2006.
