MPD officers will conduct proactive community policing beat patrol in designated neighborhoods in District 2. Beat officers will work in partnership with the community in identifying, reducing, and preventing crime impacting quality of life for residents and businesses. Patrols will focus primarily along the West National Avenue, West Mitchell Street, West Lincoln Avenue, South Cesar E Chavez Drive, and West Muskego Avenue corridors in District 2.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:  
This grant supports public safety and reduction of crime objectives.

The Beat Patrol Program provides ten communities in Wisconsin population size 25,000+ with the highest violent crime rates with funds to support police personnel to conduct community oriented policing on beat patrols.
