Common Council File No 241950 - Communication from the Department of Employee Relations amending the Salary Ordinance to provide assignment rate footnotes for Equipment Operators and Special Equipment Operators when performing demolition duties.

Dear Council Members:

This communication requests an amendment to the 2025 Salary Ordinance to provide a 5% assignment footnote to the titles of 'Special Equipment Operator III', 'Equipment Operator 3', and 'Equipment Operator 2' when incumbents of those positions are assigned to work on the demolition crew.

The DPW demolition crew is a crucial part of the Mayor's Raze and Revive effort to take down and remove certain city-owned, foreclosed properties. These properties are deemed by DCD to be hazardous to a neighborhood due to factors such as poor structural integrity and are referred to the DPW demolition crew by DCD for removal. This effort plans and has funded to raze 90 residential properties a year by the demolition crew.

## Action Required: Pay Period 11, 2025 (05/11/2025)

In the Salary Ordinance:

Under Pay Range 8FN:

Create footnote (9) and apply to the title 'Equipment Operator 2':

(9) An employee assigned to the demolition crew and called out for emergency demolition to receive an additional 5%.

Under Pay Range 8GN:

Create footnote (5) and apply to the title 'Equipment Operator 3':

(5) An employee assigned to the demolition crew and called out for emergency demolition to receive an additional 5%.

Under Pay Range 8JN:

- Create footnote (5) and apply to the title 'Special Equipment Operator 3':

(5) An employee assigned to the demolition crew and called out for emergency demolition to receive an additional 5%.
