

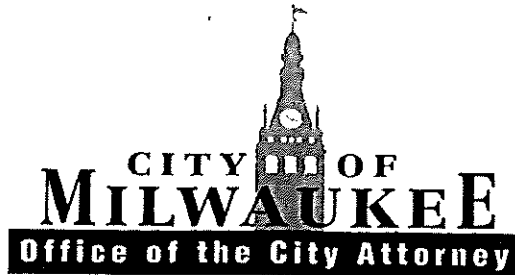

Communication from MAYOLO ARIAS

Dear Mayolo:

We have received your claim relating to property damage on October 29, 2025 when the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) made forced entry into your residence at 827 South 37th Street.

The records indicate that MPD officers were dispatched to the scene in response to a 911 call reporting a potentially dangerous situation involving possible injuries from a gunshot. Upon arrival, the officers announced their presence and knocked on the doors. A juvenile inside the residence attempted to open the door but was unable to do so and appeared frantic and confused. Given these circumstances, the officers made the decision to forcibly enter the residence to ensure the safety and welfare of all individuals inside. In this case, the officers acted in accordance with established protocols and within the scope of their employment to address an emergency situation. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. Please include a photocopy of this letter's envelope, showing the postmark, and retain the original in the event further proof is needed.

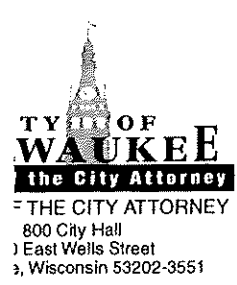
