She told me contact the department. The sheriff police department called R. C. I. W. A. C. H. or security and discuss this matter with R. C. I. staff and was told to have me file a notice of claim to obtain the cost of my lost property. I'm requesting that \$380.00 be given to me in an money order or have my property return to me as promised. I will be getting out of jail on MAY 8. 07 I will be coming to the milwaukee city clerk, 200 East Wells Street Room 205. I'm requesting a hearing. yes I like a hearing for my money or my property. Timothy Childs.

This statement gives rise to the claim for injuries, monetary damages, to the return of Your Claimant's Personal Property or the Cost of his Personal Chattle taken away from him by A African American Female Sheriff on the above-stated date.

The personal property of Your Claimant was all time mentioned in the possession of the Milwaukee Police Department Storage Room upon being confiscated from him after a car accident occurred. Your Claimant had an arrest warrant pending (lodged) against him and was arrested on sight of the car accident (on August 3 , 2005).

The personal clothes that was taken from Your Claimant is as follows: 5 T-Shirts that cost: \$20.00 per shirt; 2 shirts wit the words "Get Down, Lay It Down" that cost \$60.00 per shirt; 1 Army F. Shirt that cost \$85.00 and 3 shorts; 3 shorts that cost \$25.00 per pair; 3 shorts, black, blue and 1 light blue.

Your Claimant was placed inside the Olde Milwaukee County Bull-Pen holding cell when his property was taken from him. The female sheriff promised that Your Claimant would receive his clothes upon being released from prison. Your Claimant will be returning to society less than six months and had his Assigned Social Worker call The Milwaukee Police Department, 2620 West Wisconsin Ave, Milwaukee, Wi 53233, to see if his clothes were still there. She told Your Claimant to contact the Department. The said Police Department called RCI's Warden or Security and discussed this matter with RCI's Staff and was told to have Your Claimant filed a Notice Of Claim to obtain the cost of Your Claimant Lost Property. Now, your Claimant is requesting that \$380.00 be given to him and sent to Box 909, Sturtevant, Wisconsin 53177, in an Money Order or have Your Claimant Property be return to him as promised.
