This program would expand and strengthen Milwaukee's urban canopy through a partnered initiative between the city of Milwaukee's Forestry Services and Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD). This program would giveaway free, native trees to owner-occupied, property owners within the city of Milwaukee, sourced from the city of Milwaukee nursery.
