You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on Tuesday, November 26, 2013, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider whether to renew, renew with a suspension between 10 and 90 days, or not renew your Class "D" Operator's license.

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee, which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation, recommending nonrenewal of your Class "D" Operator's licenses based upon your non-appearance despite receiving timely notice of the hearing. This recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on Monday, November 11, 2013.

Please be advised that the Common Council will determine whether to renew, renew with a suspension between 10 and 90 days, or not renew your Class "D" Operator's licenses based upon the Findings of Fact contained within the Licenses Committee report.

You may file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. The written objections must be filed with the City Clerk by 4:45 p.m. on Thursday, November 21, 2013 in Room 205 of City Hall. If you file written objections, you or a legal representative may then also appear at the Common Council to make oral arguments supporting the written objections. You will be given approximately five minutes to present the oral argument.



Re: Report on the Renewal Application of the Class "D" Bartender

License of Cassandra L. Piotrowski

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Cassandra L. Piotrowski (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "D" Bartender License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expires at midnight, December 31, 2013.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on October 2, 2013.
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. The Milwaukee Police Department responded with a police report that could form a basis for nonrenewal or suspension of said license.
- 4. On October 30, 2013 the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the report of the Milwaukee Police Department and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police department report on November 11, 2013, commencing at 1:15 p.m. in Room 301B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the Licensee did not appear and this was her second nonappearance.
- 5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
 - A. A notice of the hearing as well as a copy of the police report was sent to Cassandra L. Piotrowski, 4508 South Howell Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53207 on October 30, 2013 by U.S. prepaid first-class mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division. The address of 4508 South Howell Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53207 is the address given by the Licensee on her application. The envelope was not returned to the License Division by the United States Postal Service. The Licensee failed to appear at the hearing on November 11, 2013.



CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- 2. Based on the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the Licensee, Cassandra L. Piotrowski has not met the criteria of Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes or Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to allow renewal of the Class "D" Bartender license based upon a second nonappearance.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council should exercise its discretion to not renew the Class "D" Bartender license held by Cassandra L. Piotrowski based upon a second nonappearance.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, recommends that the Class "D" Bartender License not be renewed based upon a second nonappearance.



Report on the Renewal Application of the Class "D" Bartender

License of Navjit Singh

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Navjit Singh (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "D" Bartender License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expires at midnight, December 31, 2013.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. On October 29, 2013, the Milwaukee Police Department responded with a police report that could form a basis for nonrenewal or suspension of said license.
- 4. On October 30, 2013 the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the report of the Milwaukee Police Department and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police department report on November 11, 2013, commencing at 1:15 p.m. in Room 301B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the Licensee did appear and he was not represented by counsel.
- 5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
 - A. On July 25, 2013 the Wisconsin Department of Transportation revoked the applicant's driver's license for one year plus 60 days for operating while intoxicated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.



- 2. Based on the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the Licensee, Navjit Singh has not met the criteria of Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes or Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to allow renewal of the Class "D" Bartender license without undergoing a ten (10) day suspension based upon the police report.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council should exercise its discretion to renew the Class "D" Bartender license held by Navjit Singh with a ten (10) day suspension based upon the police report.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, by a vote of four (4) ayes and one (1) noe recommends that the Class "D" Bartender License be renewed with a 10-day suspension based upon the police report.

Said suspension is to be in effect from midnight December 31, 2013 and for ten days thereafter.
