Dear Council Member:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Judy Hagner, PMB237 Suite 108, 478 East Altamonte Drive, Altamonte, Florida 32701 alleges on her own behalf that on April 16, 2002 she was slandered by the City of Milwaukee and its attorneys in court. Claimant further claims that she was discharged from employment by the City of Milwaukee on an unstated date. She claims damages in an amount exceeding \$50,000.00 for one of these claims; and she claims damages in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the other one.

Our investigation reveals that on April 16, 2002 no attorney representing the City of Milwaukee appeared in any court in any case touching, affecting, or relating to Claimant. Our investigation further reveals that Claimant was a temporary employee of the City numerous times and that she concluded her employment on February 11, 1986 when the City discharged her for being AWOL. Accordingly, we recommend that this claim be denied.
