## **MEL PRICE**

*was awarded medals earned for serving with bravery and honor as a United States Army Soldier during World War II on November 11, 2018 at Clement Manor, 3939 S. 92nd St. in Greenfield; and*

*WHEREAS, Mel Price was born on November 4, 1925 and raised in Milwaukee; and*

*WHEREAS, Mel Price Joined the United States Army in 1941 as a Private and served in the Pacific in the Philippines and Japan, rising through the ranks as a dedicated soldier, and earned several medals for bravely carrying out his duties in a manner becoming of a United States soldier while achieving the rank of Technician Third Grade on February 17, 1944; and*

*WHEREAS, Mel Price remained in loyal service to the United States Army until his honorable discharge on April 1, 1946; and*

*WHEREAS, After returning home to his four brothers and six sisters in Wisconsin, Mel Price continued his hobbies of riding horses and Mazurka polish dancing and worked as a Pabst Brewery worker in Milwaukee until his retirement at age 65; now, therefore, be it*
