To implement an enhanced street sweep program in the area generally bounded to the east by South 7th Street, to the north by West National Avenue, to the west by South 10th Street and to the south by West Greenfield Avenue, "No Stopping, Tow Away Zone Parking" restriction will be required on streets in the area when street sweeping operations will take place. It is proposed that the "No Stopping, Tow Away Zone Parking" restriction be placed on alternating sides of the streets in the area on the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month from April through November. Additionally, the proposed restriction will be in effect from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM on the affected side of the roadway to allow sweeping operations to be completed.
