**RE:** City of Milwaukee's 2011 Federal Legislative Package

Attached for your consideration is a proposed 2011 Federal Legislative Package for the City of Milwaukee. The proposals have been generated by City Departments, Common Council members and Mayor Barrett. Together they reflect issues of importance to the City that can be addressed by the Federal Legislature and Administration.

Departments were asked to submit items for consideration which required Federal action to provide better outcomes in one of the following strategic planning areas:

- City fiscal capacity
- Public safety
- Public Health
- City Infrastructure
- Quality of life (Education, Neighborhoods, Environment)
- Economic Well-being

This agenda is intended to help track the City's efforts at the federal level and to facilitate a consistent message in interactions with members of our federal delegation and administration officials in the 2011 Federal Legislative Session. As with the State Legislative Package, additional items may be added through separate resolution.
