Regarding: Your Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises License Applications Requesting Instrumental Musicians, Disc Jockey, Bands, Comedy Act, Motion Picture, 5 Concerts, and Special Events as agent for "Rebel, LLC" for "Snack Boys" at 814 S 2nd 

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

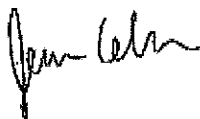
You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The premise is currently in the middle of remodeling. The applicant stated that the premise does not currently have cameras, but he plans on installing 2 on the front of the premise, and one behind the premise. He also stated that he plans to install at least 5-6 cameras in the interior that will store video footage for at least 30 days. The premise, "Snack Boys", will be a restaurant/bar, with the main kitchen closing approximately around 10pm, and will serve a "bar food" menu afterwards. The applicant stated that he does plan to have a doorman/ bouncer past the hours of 10pm/11pm, to check IDs and monitor the door. He also stated that if need be, he will hire more security personnel if the premise becomes busier on certain days and he needs extra help.

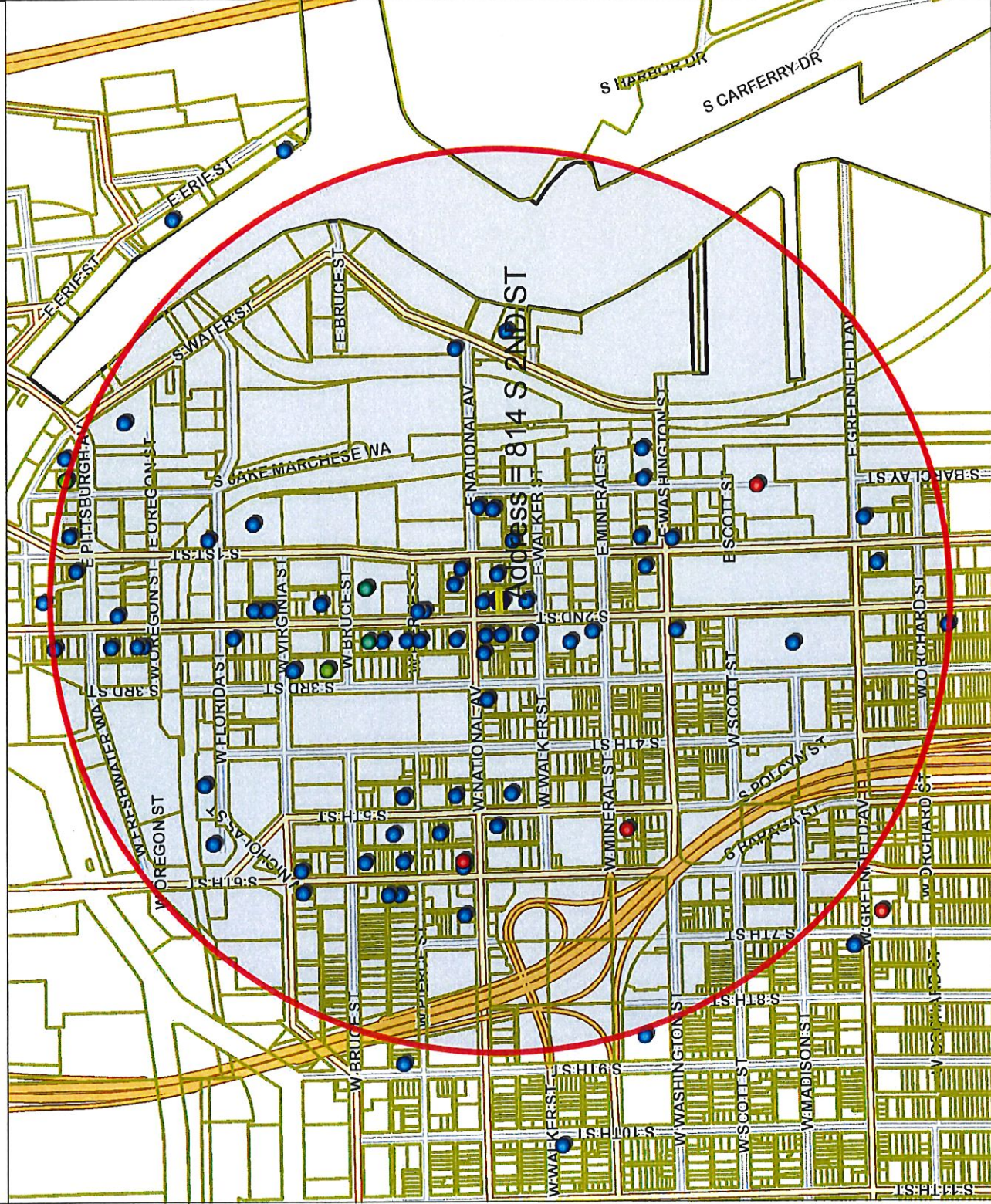

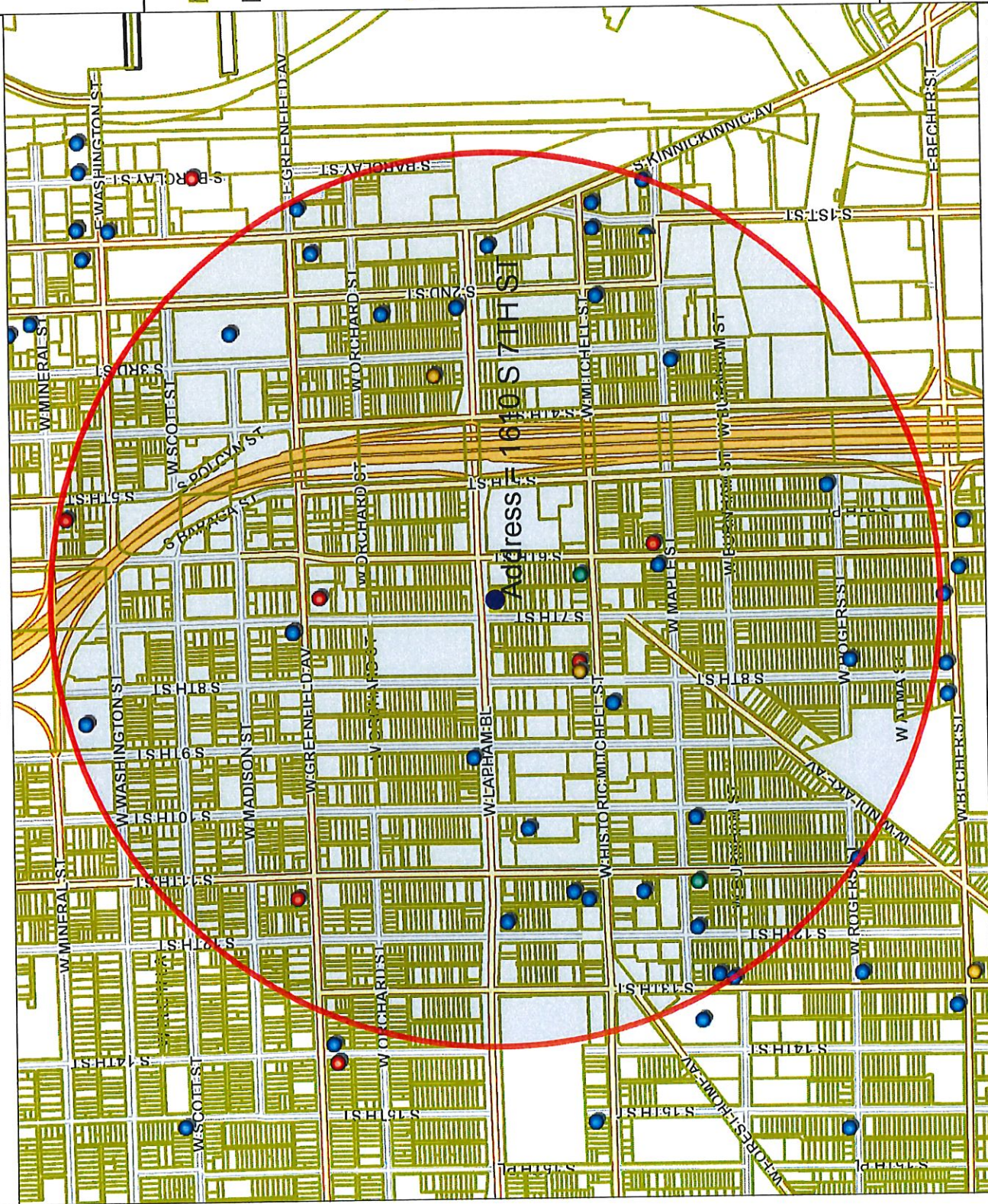

He also stated that while he doesn't have any exterior cameras on the store now, he will probably install one in the future. The licensee also stated that he doesn't know how to work his security cameras now, but a friend of his who installed the system is coming to the location to train him on how to work the cameras (record and retrieve video for police). The store does not currently have any products in the location, however, the licensee was advised about common items that some stores sell which are used for drug paraphernalia (glass "tire gauges", chore boy scrub brushes, digital scales, etc etc). The licensee stated that he doesn't want people like that patronizing his store. I also provided him with information to attend Robbery Prevention Training, which he stated he will schedule a class sometime this week.

Subject: License Renewal for Shakers, 422 South 2nd Street

Dear Honorable Members:

The Department of Public Works (DPW) has concerns regarding the operation of the parklet with attached sidewalk café at Shakers located at 422 South 2nd Street. The following provides a timeline of events related to the parklet:

- The applicant constructed and installed the parklet with attached sidewalk café in the summer of 2015 after working with DPW to develop an approvable plan. For reference, a copy of the approved DPW permit with plan and comments is attached.
- On March 30, 2016, the Milwaukee Fire Department contacted DPW regarding the parklet and use of the adjacent alley to store furniture to be used with the parklet and sidewalk café. DPW personnel contacted the applicant's representative regarding this matter and the furniture was relocated within a matter of days.
- On June 15, 2016, the Milwaukee Fire Department contact DPW regarding the presence of tall palms placed between the street light pole and the north end of the parklet structure. The plants were creating a site distance obstruction to vehicles turning onto South 2nd Street from the east-west alley. DPW personnel contacted the applicant's representative requesting that the plants be relocated either against the building or to the south end of the parklet structure. The applicant did relocate the plants in a timely manner.
- On August 11, 2017, DPW received an ADA complaint due to the presence of tables and chairs abutting the building and in the 5-foot wide pedestrian clear path along South 2nd Street. DPW referred this complaint to the Department of Neighborhood Services (DNS) and the City of Milwaukee's ADA Coordinator. The applicant removed the tables during a site visit that day by the ADA Coordinator.
- On August 14, 2017, in response to the ADA complaint of August 11, 2017, DNS requested a copy of their submitted plan, which led to DPW requesting a copy of the plan from License Division. After a search of its records, License Division determined that there had not been a sidewalk café license or permit at this establishment since before 2014.
- On October 4, 2017, DPW personnel performed a site visit to review the applicant's sidewalk café license application. Several problematic items were observed during the site visit including the placement of tall plants on the parklet structure; placement of a planter in the adjacent east-west alley; storage of extra tables, chairs, and a moveable bar on the sidewalk at



the north end of parklet structure; and the presence of flag signs on poles mounted to the west side of the parklet structure that are approximately 17 feet tall and project into the traffic lanes on South 2nd Street. The flag signs are prohibited under Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 295-407-9-a. For reference, photos from the site visit are attached.

The Department of Public Works requests that the concerns observed be corrected by the applicant as follows:

- Remove all tall plants from the parklet structure in order to ensure clear lines of sight for vehicles turning out of the adjacent east-west alley.
- Remove all excess sidewalk café furniture from the public right-of-way including excess chairs, tables, planters and the moveable bar.
- Remove the flag signs and associated poles from the public right-of-way.
- Remove the planter from the adjacent east-west alley.

Should the Licenses Committee choose to approve the sidewalk café license for this establishment, the Department of Public Works requests the following conditions:

- That any and all sidewalk café furniture, including but not limited to, tables, chairs, planters, and umbrellas be located on the parklet structure at all times. Sidewalk café furnishings may not be stored or used in the east west alley or on the portion of the sidewalk that is not occupied by the parklet structure.
- That nothing overhang the edge of the parklet structure handrail including, but not limited to plants, planters, and umbrellas.
- That no planters or planters taller than 18 inches be placed on the parklet structure.
- That all signage comply with Section 295-407 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and all necessary permits be acquired prior to installation.
- That the applicant install and maintain the following traffic control devices in good working order: a hazard marker on the south end of the structure; a delineator tube on the north end of the structure; and one wheel stop on each end of the structure. Should the aforementioned devices fall into disrepair, the applicant shall obtain replacement devices as necessary.
- That the parklet structure may only occupy the public right-of-way between March 15th and November 15th annually.

Permit Review Comments

The following comments apply to all work done near water mains and their appurtenances:

1. Prior to proceeding with construction, the location of each water main shall be determined in the field by contacting "Diggers Hotline".
2. Maintain a minimum of 6" vertical clearance from the outside edge of the proposed installation (or boring) to the O.D. of Water Main (or appurtenance).
2. A minimum of 2'-0" of undisturbed earth shall be maintained from the excavation limits of the proposed installation (including soil borings and when the boring method of construction is employed), to the O.D. of the existing Water Main as well as to the outside edge of any existing Fire Hydrant (or appurtenance).
2. A minimum of 3'-0" of clearance shall be maintained from the outside edge of the proposed aboveground installation (such as: fence, pole, etc.) to the outside edge of any Fire Hydrant.
5. Maintain access to all Fire Hydrants within the construction area for fire protection, and protect all hydrants against damage for the duration of the project.

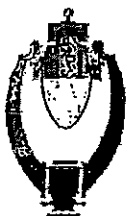

Per our phone conversation yesterday, I have modified the drawings and created a Western Profile as well.

Items to note. The proposed parklet will be made of wooden decking over the parking spaces and at the curb edge it will be textured steel plate that, similar in appearance to the steel front step of Shaker's itself. I am told that this is similar to the construction at Black Sheep up the street.

The existing control joint running North South along the sidewalk is 64" from the lowest step into the entrance of Shaker's and 60 inches from the Southwest corner of the structure. For the drawing I call out the steel plate meeting with the control joint and clearly call out that 5' will be unimpacted by the parklet, between the parklet and the most Eastern point of the structure. I've also called out the 1' set back from the Eastern most edge of the Bicycle lane and the 4' offset from the Southern edge of the Alley; in the respective profiles.

Lastly, the railing, to be wood, will be extended onto the steel decking and will match the railing about the rest of the parklet. This will prevent entrance onto the parklet from the North and South.

I believe these were the requirements that you listed to initiate routing today.

Everyone at Shaker's is very excited to move forward and are now going to focus on finishing the amendment to the Extension of Premises.

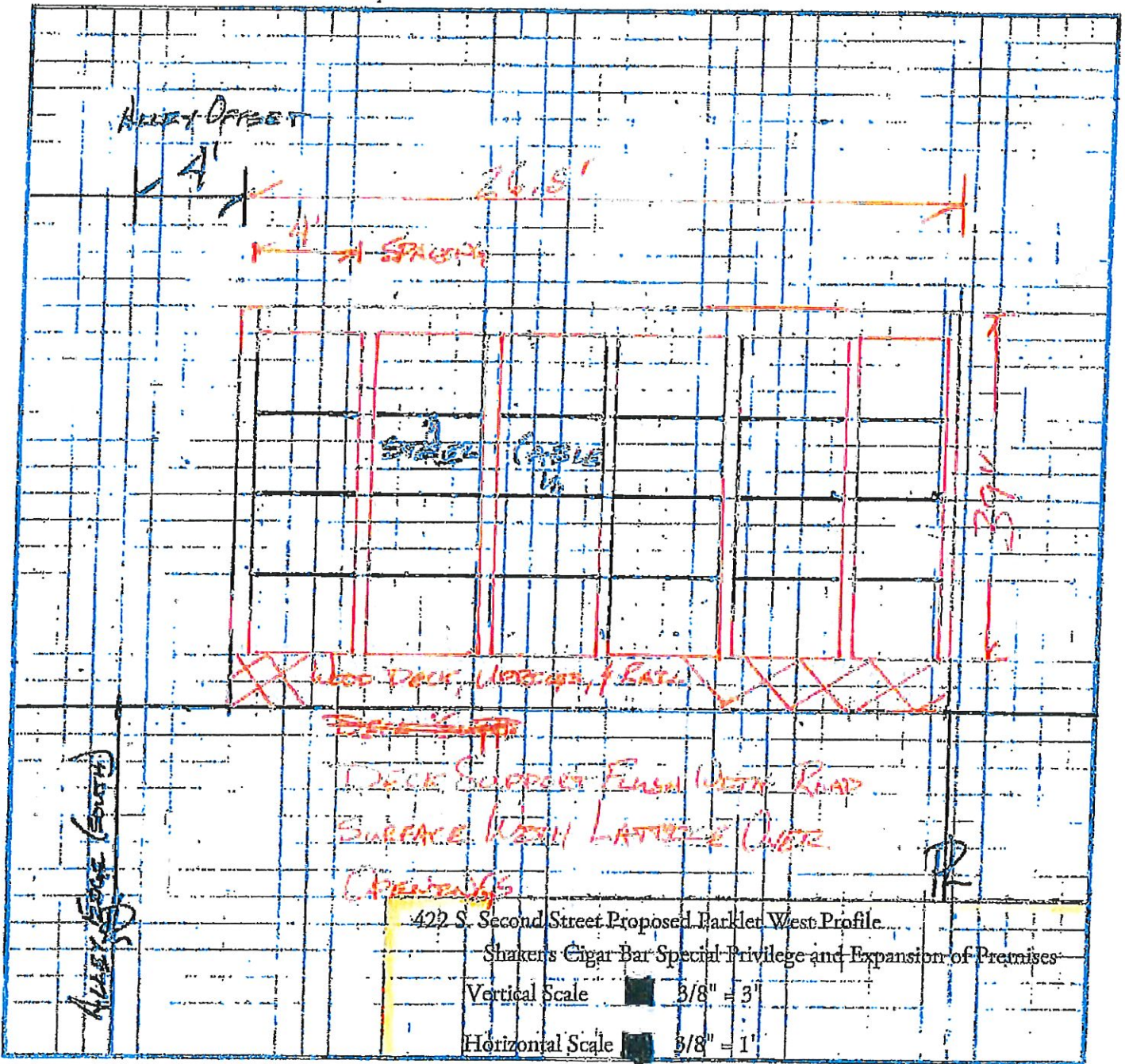
