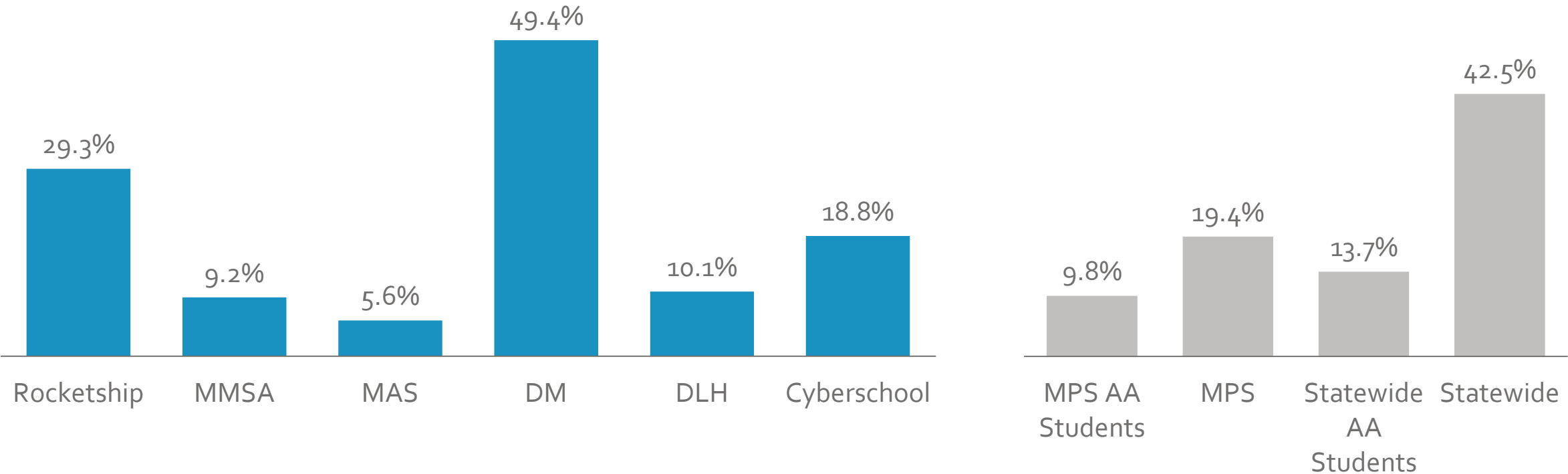

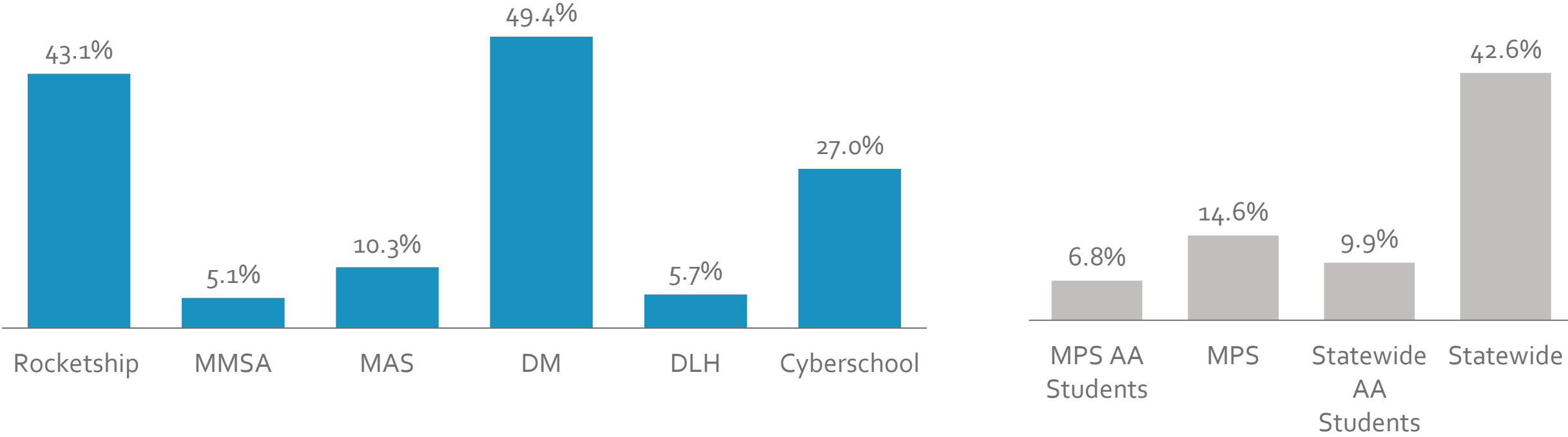

Percent Proficient (Grades 3–8)

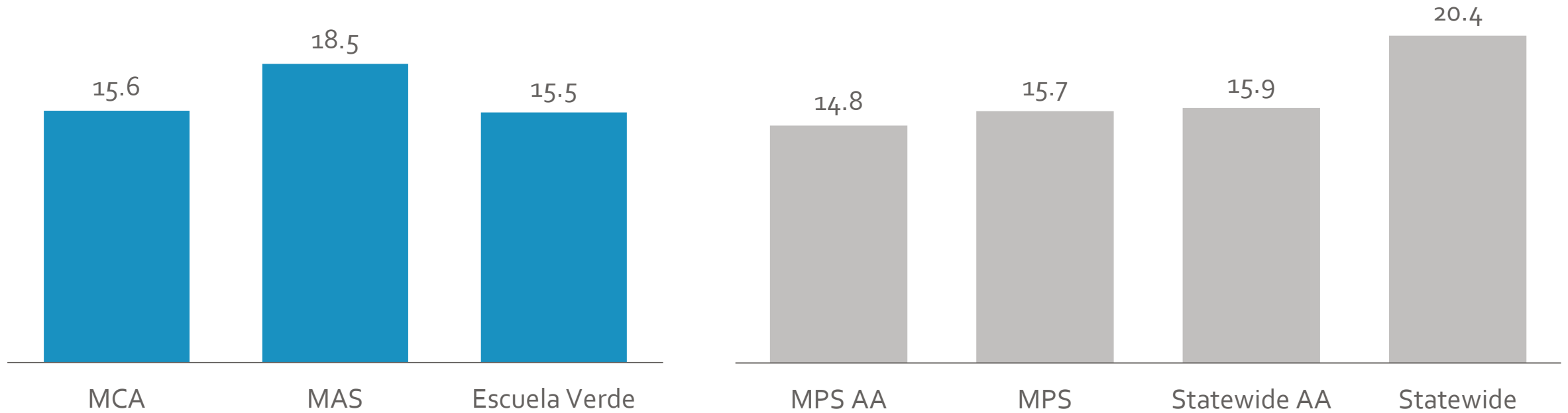


Forward Exam Math 2015–16 Percent Proficient (Grades 3–8)



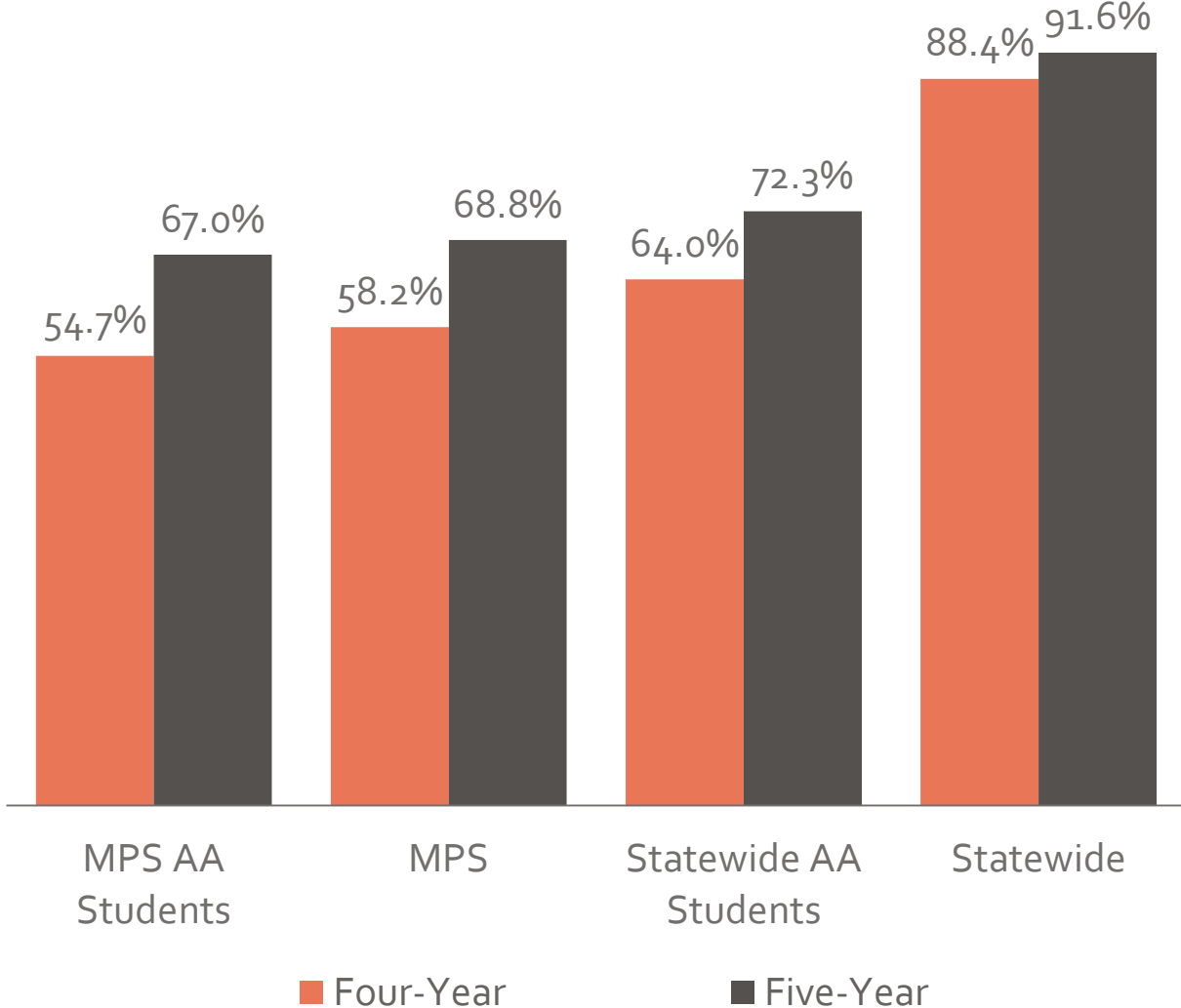
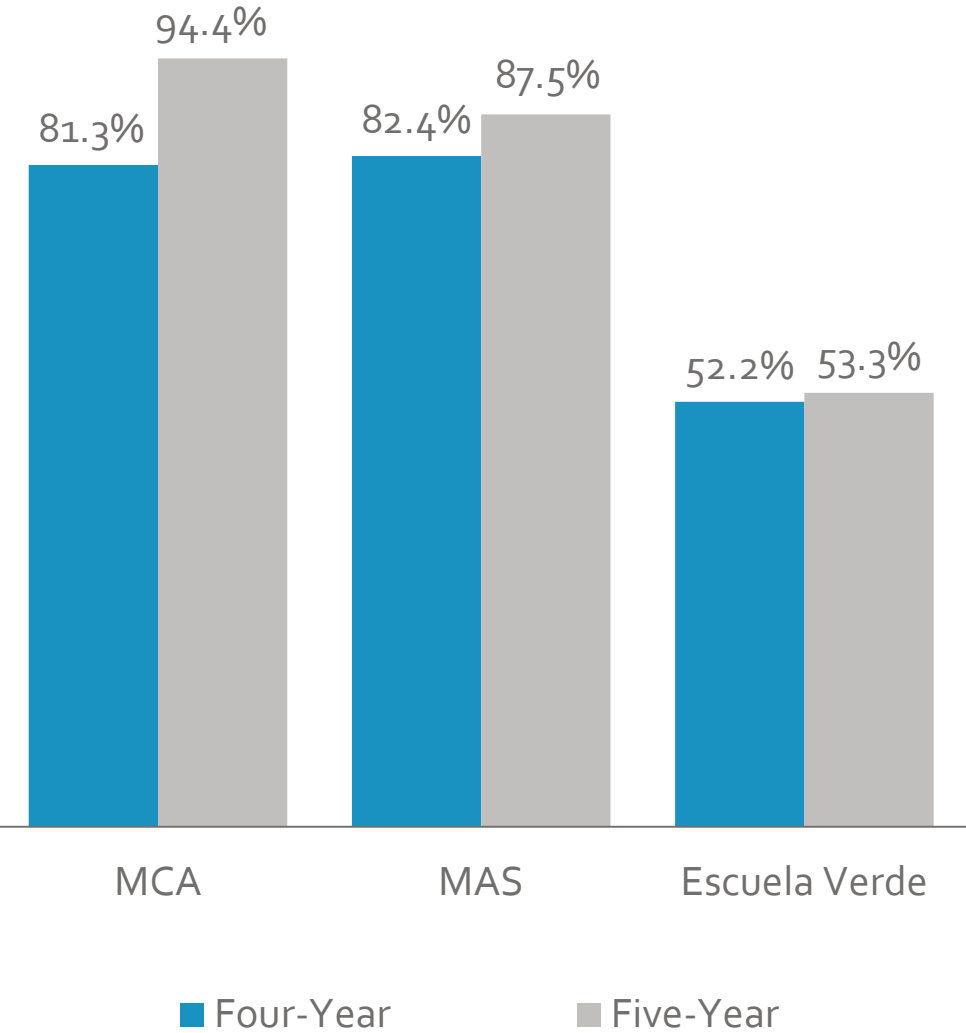

Average Composite ACT Scores: 2015–16 Graduates

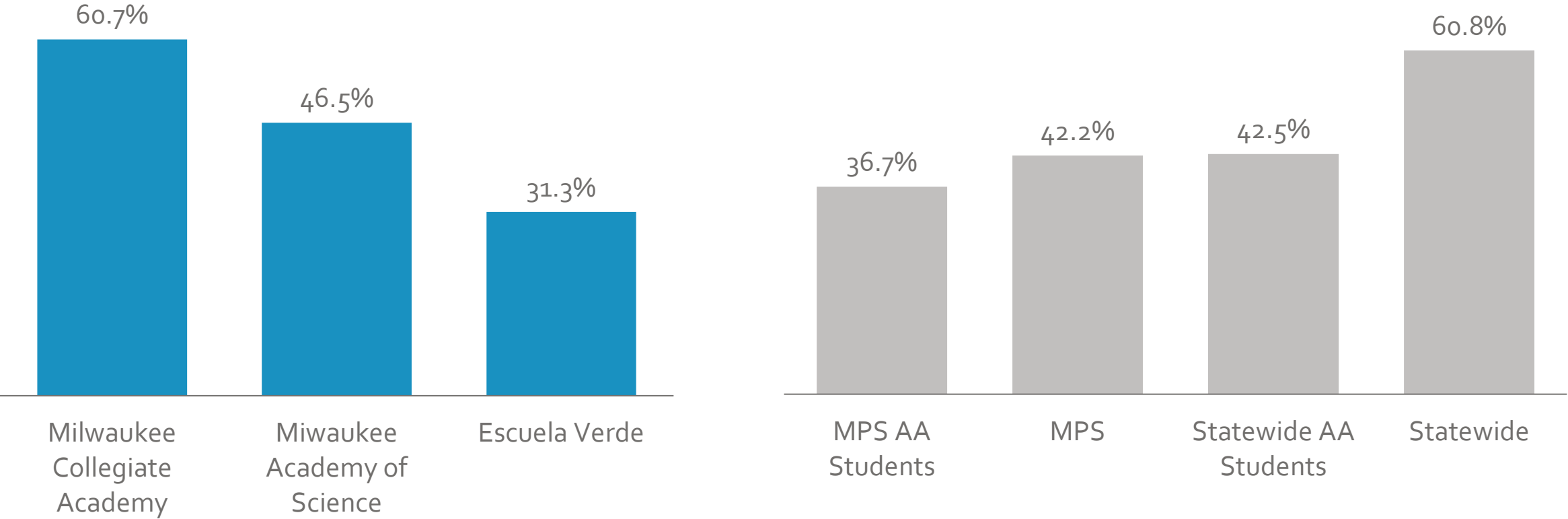

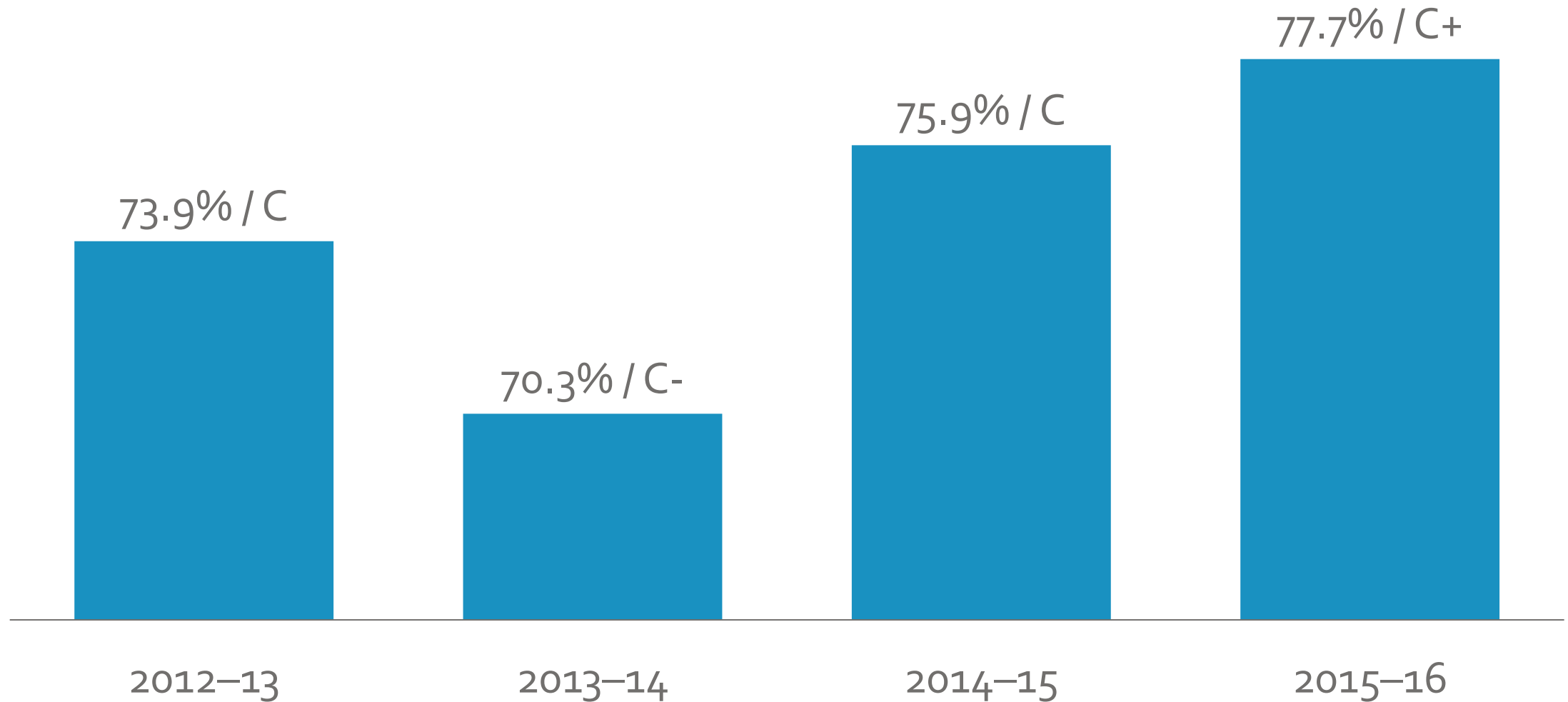

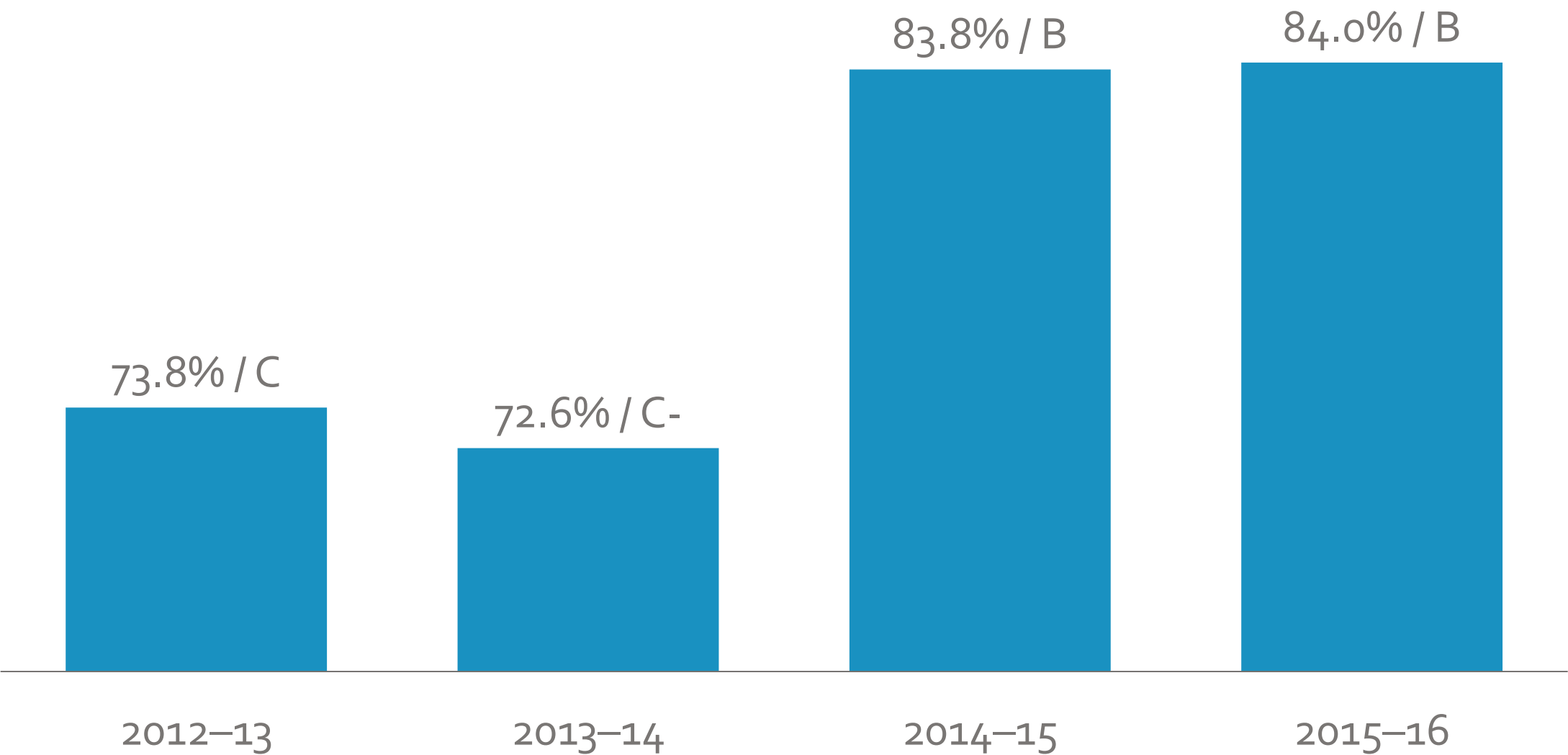
