MANY NEW EDIFICES BUILT OR PRO-
JECTED.

The Tendency to Handsome Houses of
Worship, Lavish Outlay and Mod-
ern Innovations in the Way
of Arrangement.

The Second German Episcopal church building, at the corner of Second and Garfield avenues, will cost \$15,000. It is in the form of a Greek cross, and is 50x70 feet ground measurement. It is of stone and brick veneer construction, and is thirty feet high, with a tower reaching skyward 130 feet.
