Enclosed please find a proposed resolution. We ask that this be considered by the Committee on Judiciary and Legislation with the following recommendation.

The plaintiff, Terry Williams, filed a lawsuit against the City of Milwaukee seeking damages as a result of an accident occurring on November 6, 2002 when he tripped on a City sidewalk near North 8th Street and West State Street.

This matter was tried before a Milwaukee County jury on November 22, 2004 before the Honorable Victor Manian. The jury found the City 90% negligent, with plaintiff 10% negligent. Ninety percent of the assessed damages totals \$27,833.18. Plaintiff is legally entitled to recover litigation costs of \$1,001.40.
