File No. 031126 is a resolution authorizing the Milwaukee Fire Department to accept and expend a grant up to \$280,000 to support the Metropolitan Medical Response System. (Fire Department)

## **Background**

The United States Department of Health and Human Services administers a Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program.

This is a 2-year grant. The contract is awarded unilaterally.

The program helps municipalities that want to enhance their preparedness in the event of domestic terrorism.

#### Discussion

- 1. File 031126 provides for accepting and expending up to \$280,000 from a U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) grant for the following:
  - \$153,810 for authority and Salary funding for 1 **newly created** MMRS Coordinator, Pay Range 863, Step 6 position (from October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2005)
  - \$47,681 for fringe benefits for 1 MMRS Coordinator, Pay Range 863, Step 6 position
  - \$64,620 for Supplies and Materials, including a Mark IV kit and pharmaceuticals
  - \$13,889 for Defibrillator/Monitor Equipment
- 2. No City contribution is required.
- 3. The grant award letter indicates that reimbursements to the MFD may be made upon the receipt of an MFD invoice upon project completion and the contractual reviews.
- 4. The MFD is responsible for preparing and submitting (1) an Inventory of Capability Report, (2) a "Sustainment Plan), and (3) an "Operational Verification Report". The payment schedule reimburses the MFD in (1) \$50,000, (2) \$150,000, and (3) \$80,000 increments.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

This resolution authorizes the MFD to apply, accept and expend up to \$280,000 for salaries, fringe benefits, supplies, materials, and equipment using grants from the FY2003 US Department of Health and Human Services Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program.
