*Ald. Mark Chambers, Jr. appeared and had fiscal, equity, design, and consensus concerns on the proposed city flag. A number of committee members shared the same sentiment.*

*Ald. Charlen Moore and a number of committee members want finality on this matter*

*and do not want to spend more time or resources for further deliberation or to restart the process.*

*Amber Danyus said that the Mayor did not have an official position on the matter.*
