Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/13/11 at 10:45 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a noise complaint at 520 E Center Street. Police spoke to the caller who stated the bar has been playing loud music since 7 pm with the front door left open. The caller stated this was an on going problem and wanted a citation issued. Investigation revealed that no patrons were in the bar, however officers found the music to be extremely loud. Police spoke with Youssouf Komara who told police he did have the door open earlier in the night to let the fresh air in, but that it was not open past 10 pm. Other officers who were in the area observed the front door to be open at approximately at 10:50 pm prior to police arrival. Komara was advised there was a complaint and that he would be receiving a citation.

2. On 01/29/12 at 12:08 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Fight complaint at 520 E Center Street. Officers spoke with Youssouf Komara who stated there was a brief scuffle on the dance floor and that he broke it up and the individuals involved were escorted off the premises. Komara stated there were no injures during the altercation. Officers were then dispatched to an area hospital for a battery complaint that resulted from the fight that occurred at 520 E Center earlier. Police attempted to speak with the victim, however he was sedated

due to shock. The victim had convulsions and had to be restrained by hospital personnel. Officers spoke with the victim's girlfriend who stated a fight involving numerous individuals broke out on the dance floor and that her boyfriend attempted to break it up when he was hit in the head with a glass bottle. The victim's laceration required 12 staples and police were advised by the treating physician that the victim was going to be kept sedated until he could be taken off of the ventilator.

3. On 06/11/12 at 12:50 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint located at 520 E Center Street. On scene, officers observed the bar for approximately 10 minutes from a distance and were unable to hear loud music. Officers attempted to speak with the caller, but were unable to make contact with him. Police spoke with the bartender Monica Clark, and found that Clark did not possess a valid Class D Bartenders license and that the licensee, Youssouf Komara, was not on scene. Clark stated she was closing the bar and was finished for the night. Citations were issued to Clark and Komara for the violations.

- 4. On 06/30/12 at 1:45 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 520 E Center Street for a Shooting complaint. Investigation revealed a patron and one of his friends stepped outside the bar, around the corner, to have a cigarette, when they approached by two males who robbed the victims. During the robbery, one suspect shot one of the victims in the chest with the victim stumbling back into the bar, where he fell to the floor. The victim was conveyed to an area hospital where he was pronounced dead. The bar owner, Youssouf Komara, stated to police that he knew the victim and that he had concerns regarding a tattoo parlor that recently opened next door and that never seems to close. Komara stated that there are always people hanging outside and that there are occasional fights and implied that the shooting possibly was related to the tattoo business.
- 5. On 06/30/13, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 418 E Center for a Call For Police complaint. An anonymous caller stated that several males and females were outside the tavern screaming. Upon arrival, police observed several subjects outside the bar smoking, no one was yelling. Police advised the bar employees to keep as many people inside the bar and to keep the noise down.
- On 10/27/2013 Milwaukee police responded to 520 East Center Street (Club Timbuktu) to conduct follow up regarding a battery complaint that occurred on 10/14/2013. The applicant

told officers the victim became involved in an altercation with one or two females while inside the business. The victim was escorted out because she was being loud and disorderly. He is not aware of any additional problems.

7. On 01/19/2019 a battery occurred outside of Club Timbuktu, 520 E. Center St. on 01/20/2019 the officers conducted follow up and could not locate any cameras that captured the incident.

8. On 12/31/20 at 10:10pm, officers conducted a License Premise Check at Club Timbuktu, 520 E Center St. Officers found the business to be open with patrons and a DJ playing music. Officers checked the licenses and found they had expired and were not valid. Officers spoke to the DJ, who became argumentative and accused the officers of harassment. The agent was on scene was cooperative and stated they must have forgot to renew the licenses and agreed to close the bar.

This Report is written by PO Russell MACRAE assigned to District 5 - LATE POWER TAVERN CAR

On 12/31/20 at 10:10pm, PO David LETTEER and I (SQ#5468), along with PO Adam MARITATO and PO Robert PARKS (SQ#5469) conducted a Tavern Check at CLUB TIMBUKTU located at 520 E Center Street. Upon arrival, there were (20) Patrons inside the tavern. We made contact with the Licensee who was bartending identified as Youssouf KAMARA (B/M 03/03/62) and informed him that we were conducting a routine check of the business licenses. Upon inspection of the licenses, it was discovered that the tavern did not hold any current licenses at the time of our check. During our license check, I made contact with the only other employee working which was the DJ who was playing music. The DJ later identified himself as Gideon W. VERDIN-WILLIAMS (B/M 06/08/80). VERDIN-WILLIAMS was extremely argumentative and accused us in harassment of black-owned bars; he continued and stated that we should leave and go down to Water Street to check white-bars.

KAMARA told PO LETTEER and I that the renewal paperwork must've been forgotten about and that he would voluntarily close to alleviate any potential problems. KAMARA further stated that the behavior of the hired DJ (VERDIN-WILLIAMS) is unacceptable and that he would not hire him to work in his tavern again.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 11/30/2021 at 09:15 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
