File #051663 is a substitute resolution authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works to install traffic control improvements in conjunction with a Hazard Elimination Safety Grant for the intersection of West Center Street and North Teutonia Avenue in the 15th Aldermanic District at a total estimate cost of \$21,514.84 with an estimated City Share of \$2,151.48.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

- 1. This substitute resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to install traffic control improvements at the intersection of West Center Street and North Teutonia Avenue at a total estimate cost of \$21,514.84 with an estimated City Share of \$2,151.48. The Surface Transportation Program (STP) provides cost participation for the construction of traffic control improvements with Federal Highway Safety Funds under the 2006 Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Program.
- 2. Common Council File #051253, adopted February 7, 2006, approved the preliminary engineering for the traffic control improvements at this intersection. A safety audit was conducted at the intersection of Center Street and North Teutonia Avenue under the Roadway Improvement Demonstration Program sponsored by the American Automobile Assocation (AAA). The audit found a high number of rear end, angle and pedestrian-related crashes. The proposed improvements, based on the audit, include pavement markings, designating left-turn lanes, stop bars; upgrading signals to 12" LED lenses; pedestrian LED "Walk/Don't Walk" combination housings and the installation of mast arms and back plates. A breakdown of the original costs included:

- 3. In this resolution, the total estimated construction costs is \$21,514.84, with \$19,363.36, 90%, provided by the HES grant and \$2,151.48, 10% provided by the city. The cost for the construction increased by \$764.84, 3.2%, due to the cost of materials.
- 4. According to the construction agreement, the approximate start date is July 2006, with completion by December 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT

- 1. The estimated construction cost for the installation of traffic control improvements at the intersection of West Center Street and North Teutonia Avenue through the Hazard Elimination Safety Grant is \$21,514.84, with the grantor share providing \$19,363.36, 90%, and the City share is \$2,151.48, 10%.
- 2. The City funding is through the 2006 capital improvements fund, the Paving Program-Street Reconstruction-City Contribution to State and Federally Aided Projects.
